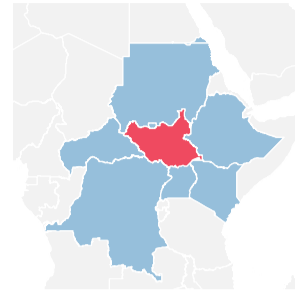

REFUGEE RETURNEES IN Apr 2022

The East and Horn of Africa and Great Lakes region is host to some **4.96 million refugees and asylum seekers**, the majority (2.29 million) from South Sudan. A further **12.64 million** people are **internally displaced** in the region, as a result of conflict and natural disasters. Some **10,970 refugees returned** to their countries of origin in March 2022.

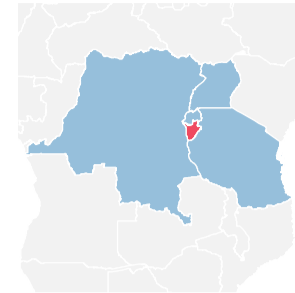

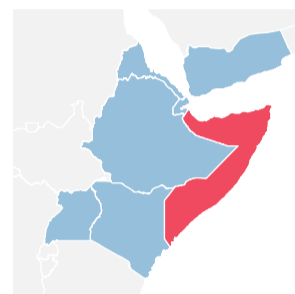

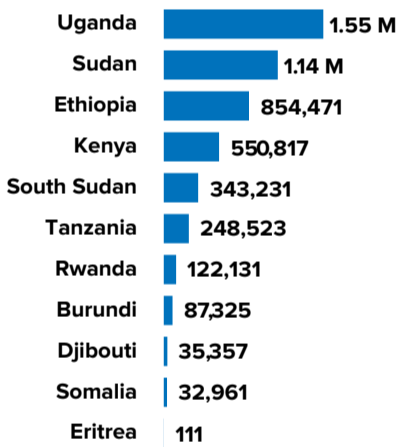

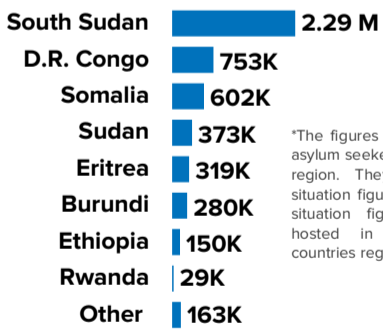

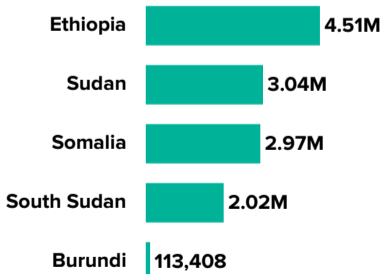

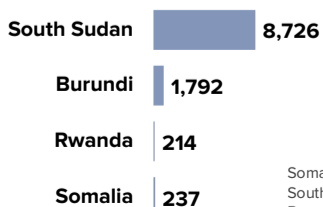

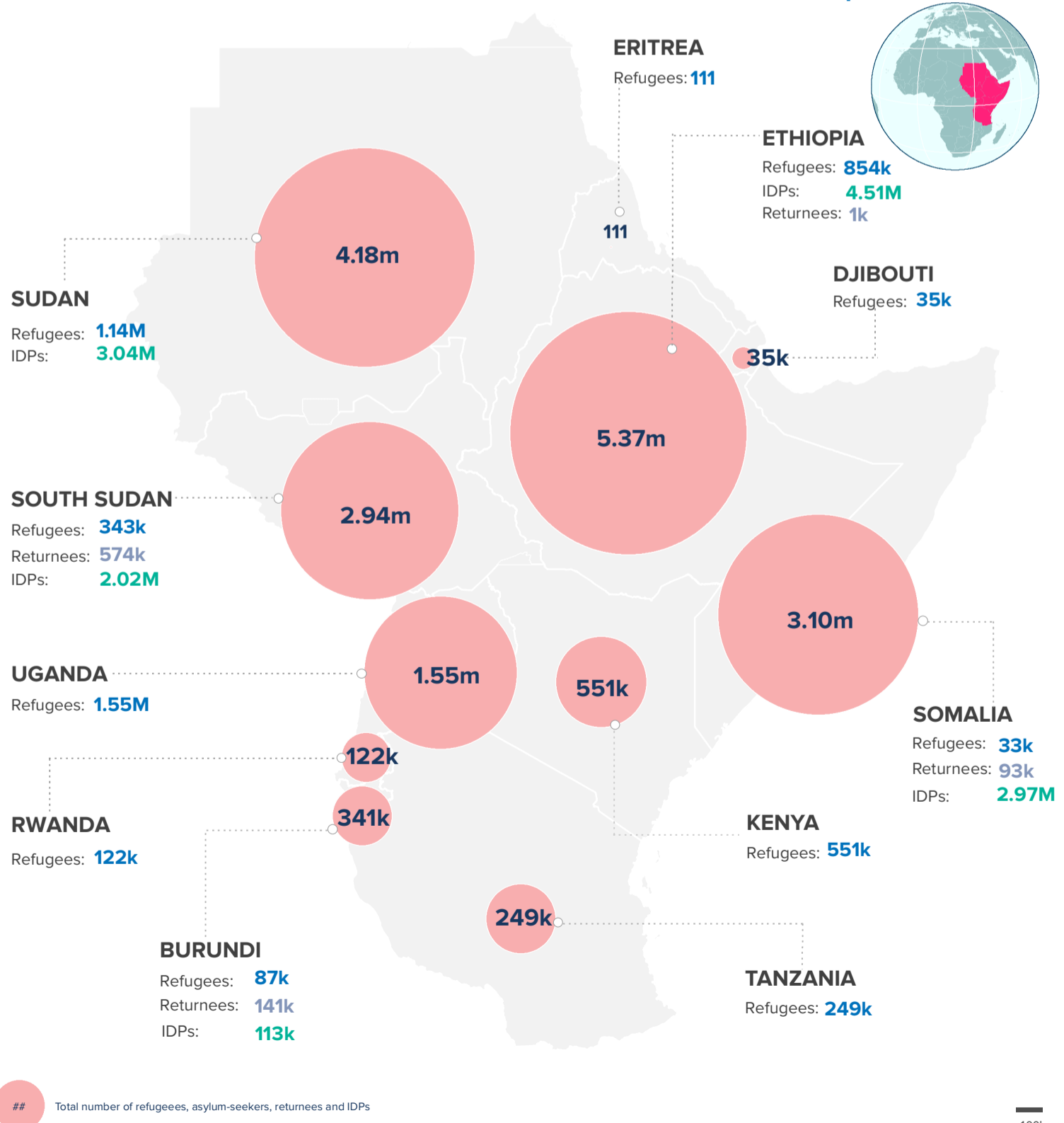


REFUGEE RETURNEES IN APRIL
