


In Rakhine State, 65,741 persons remain displaced as of July 2022 in 10 townships due to the AA-Tatmadaw conflict. In collaboration with partners and other UN agencies, UNHCR is responding to the humanitarian needs and continues to provide assistance to affected communities.

From January to June 2022, UNHCR provided core relief items, emergency shelter support, dignity kits and cloth masks to some 24,069 individuals in Mrauk-U, Myebon, Kyauktaw, Minbya, Ponnagyun, Sittwe, Buthidaung and Rathedaung townships.


Over 100 field visits have been conducted, access to some sites remains limited, particularly in more rural areas, a situation which has been further exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic.

## Number of persons reached per month




**73** Displacement Sites reached with assistance in Rakhine State
