


### **VERIFIED IDP SITES IN BAIDOA AS OF JULY 2022**



Map of verified IDP sites in Baidoa - July 2022


#### **Assessment overview**

A joint IDP site verification exercise was conducted in Baidoa in July 2022. The operation was led by SWSCRI, ACTED, AMARD, CESDO, DRC, IOM, IRW, SCI, WHO, WRRS and UNHCR. 498 IDP sites were identified hosting 89,476 households or 596,931 individuals. Compared to the last site verification conducted in October 2021, there was a decrease of 74 IDP sites. The decrease may be attributed to some of the sites not meeting the IDP site definition criteria\*. In terms of IDP population, there was an increase of 20,842 Households (121,896 individuals). The increase may be attrributed to displacements due to the current drought\*\* experienced within Somalia. 82 (16%) IDP sites were established this year (2022).

\*IDP site definition criteria for South West State - only considers IDP sites hosting more than 100 households

## People living with disability

Using the washington group disability questions, statistics of people living with disabilities were derived

**6,053 (1.01%)**people living with disability

- 1,430 (51% Female) have difficulty with seeing (even wearing glasses)

  1,090 (49% Female) have difficulty with hearing (even using a hearing aid)
- 1,090 (49% Female) have difficulty with hearing (even using a hearing aid)

  \*\*\* 858 (47% Female) have difficulty with communicating and/or understanding
- 1,094 (50% Female) have difficulty with walking and/or climbing stairs
- **816** (50% Female) have difficulty with dressing and/or washing
- 765 (49% Female) have difficulty with remembering/concentrating

# **Eviction Risk Mapping**

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been issued recently.

14% of IDP sites have been classified as having extreme (8%) and high (6%) risk of eviction

66% of sites have landowner authorized occupancy type of tenure

67% of sites have agreement in place

86% of those that have agreements have written agreements


78% of those that have agreements have agreed end dates

8% of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months

## Flood Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of flooding.

102 IDP sites (20%) have been classified as extreme (always floods) and high (floods frequently)
