Welcome and action points	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Action points from previous meeting were reviewed- The meeting began with the presentation of the participating organizations and with discussions about their progress in the last two weeks and the problems they faced related to MHPSS field.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- N/A
Emergency Response Plan	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Needs Assessment: WHO (Sorana) presented the findings of the MHPSS Needs Assessment for The Front-line Workers.- WHO (Sorana) presented the results of the second mapping exercise of MHPSS services conducted in Romania.	

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - MdM underlined that the trainings needs to be done inside the organizer inside one organization. The answer has to be provided by the organizational parts, not individual parts. - MoH (Gabi) spoke with the College of Psychologists to invite them to discuss existing psychological services and aligning these services with minimum quality standards. Another problem brought up with the College of Psychologists is that of access to psychological services. - MoH also drew attention to the need to evaluate people who are victims of cruelty and torture in order to document their path in terms of the trauma suffered. - UNICEF mentioned the need to be able to have a referral system especially for children. And the need to be able to see where some refugees can go to receive MHPSS services. One of the main challenges seen is actually where to address children. They are getting quite a lot of questions. - WHO has presented the data gathered so far in relation to Referral Pathways organized by type of beneficiaries and the types of services offered. - Estuar Foundation talked about one of their services – same online webinars that they started to support the specialists and now they have some follow up sessions. The last one was organized yesterday and they will continue with this series. The meetings are on Thursdays between 12:00 to 2:30. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - WHO will load the infographic of the Needs Assessment an from the Mapping of MHPSS Services to the share point. - WHO will finalize the list of Organizations that offer MHPSS services to make it available to those interested and even to be available in centers. MdM is planning to have a mobile unit to address MHPSS services and sexual and reproductive health. - Estuar (Amedeea) will share the contact ore the site where other people working in the MHPSS field can enroll their seminars.
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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - WHO presented the gaps identified in the PESEAH meeting and UNICEF MENTIONED that this is a topic that was raised before also by UNICEF towards all the high level and there's a lot of technical assistance offered on say and gender based violence. - MdM -suggested maybe it would be of interest to invite other people from different sectors relating to MHPSS, due to the transversal specifics of MHPSS. - There also MdM suggested to have a psychiatrist invited on the MHPSS Swg. - Estuar presented the ROMEXPO center and the status of the actions taken there. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - MHPSS Lead will participate to the opening witch is established for the 20th of June.
