#### Introductions

#### Updates from participants

- New posters shared by the IASC Secretariat will be shared in the PSEA resources folder in SharePoint.
- IOM also have resources to share with the Network.

#### Interagency Minimum Operating Standards

- The IASC Minimum Operating Standards on PSEA were presented by WVI. The aim of presenting them was to encourage the adoption of common standards amongst Network participants, which would supporting the building or strengthening of PSEA frameworks.
- Participants were encouraged to provide their feedback to the IASC MOS, particularly to add information speaking to the national/local context.

#### Presentation

- **WVI** presented on their tool on Child and Adult Safeguarding. It is a pre-populated tool with risks for different sectors e.g., WASH, Child Protection. The risk level is associated with the project, staffing and program specific activities.
- While the tool was found to be useful, several participants pointed out the need for common interagency platforms.

- Bilateral meetings to map out existing reporting channels.
