Dopomoha needs to be updated with the most up to date and accurate information  Challenges in filling out 5W	Participants to update on whether any gaps have been met in interim period.

	<p>Lack of engagement of some WG participants</p> <p>We are being more reactive than proactive at this stage</p> <p>Need timely needs assessments to inform the response while not fatiguing refugees and stakeholders with repetitive uncoordinated assessments</p> <p>Ukrainians need greater facilitated access to register for temporary protection</p> <p>Need for more IM support, specifically in Education WG</p> <p>Difficulty in setting targets and indicators</p> <p>High turnover of international staff due to emergency deployments</p> <p>Gaps in data on unaccompanied minors</p> <p>Need to harmonize approach of interventions and training packages</p> <p>Not clear how to move forward while waiting for official issuance of the National Action Plan</p> <p>Need to prepare for potential escalation of conflict in western Ukraine/Odessa; 700-800k could be expected to cross via Moldova</p> <p>Need for a virtual warehouse to track CRIs and to be able to respond to requests when gaps/needs emerge</p> <p>Challenges in liaising with government actors with regard to mapping GBV referral pathways</p>	
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	<p>Need to address de-duplication in provision of cash</p> <p>There is clearly the need and appetite for cash assistance, but we can't scale up fast enough</p> <p>Additional IM support is coming to provide additional support to inter-agency work</p>
