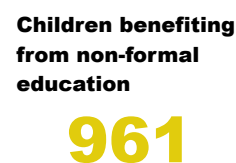
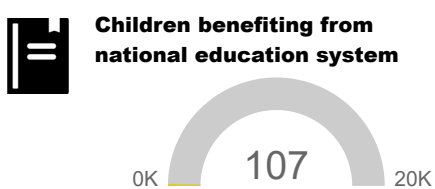
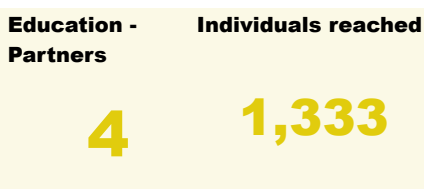
ACHIEVEMENTS BY SECTOR

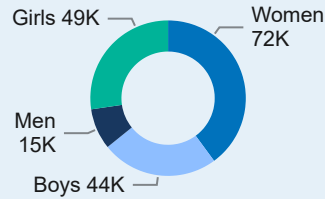


INDIVIDUALS REACHED & PARTNERS BY SECTOR

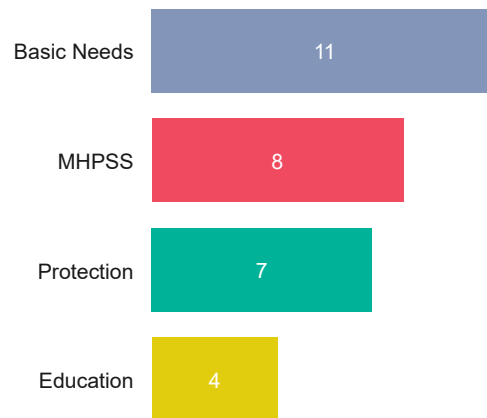

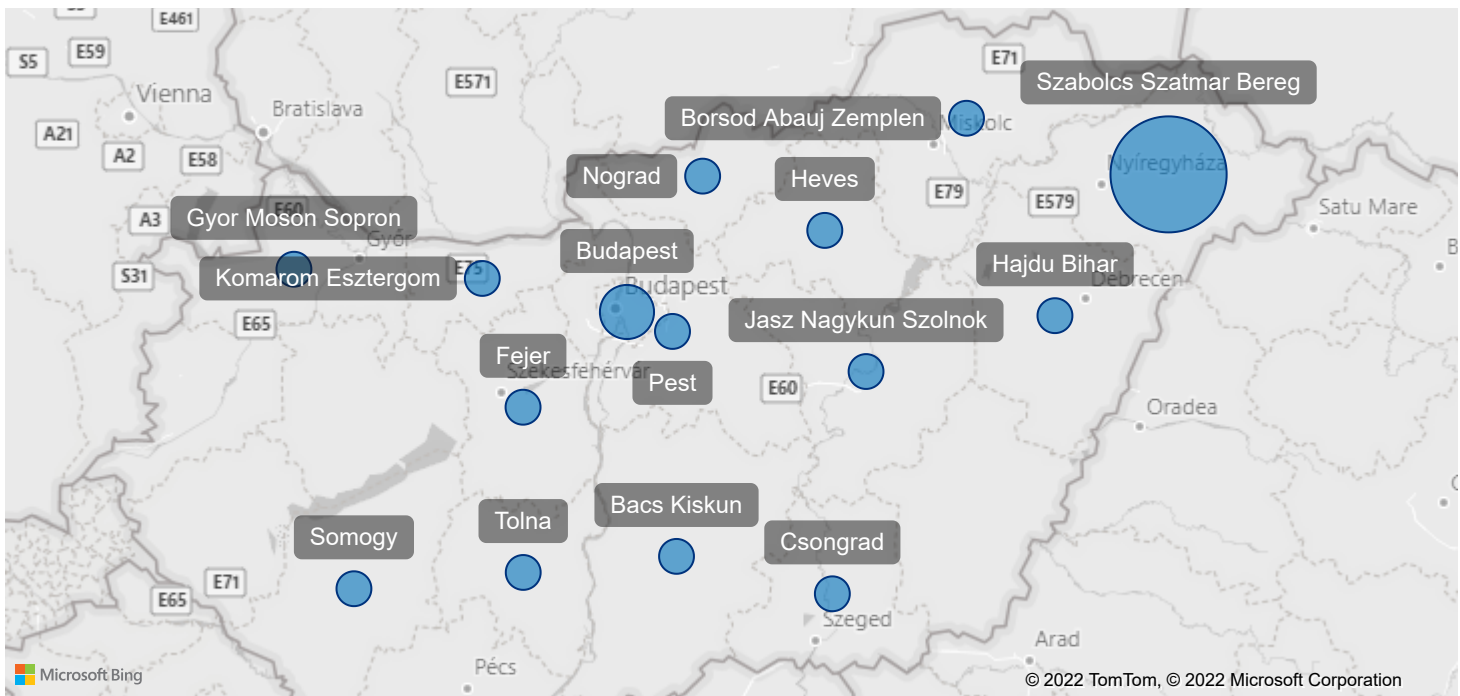
