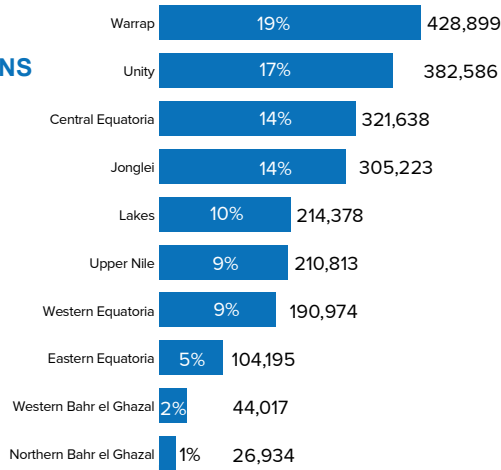


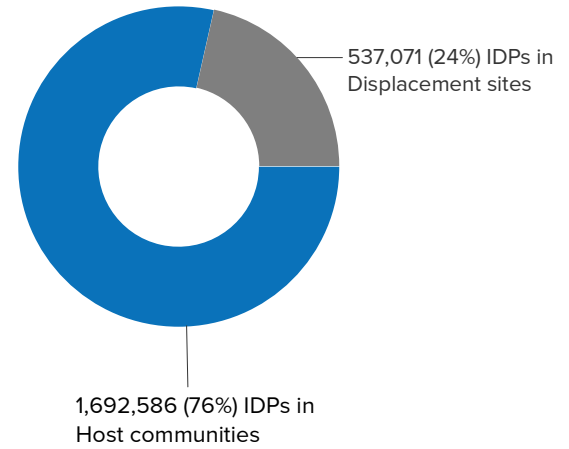
2.2 MILLION

NUMBER OF IDPS PER STATE

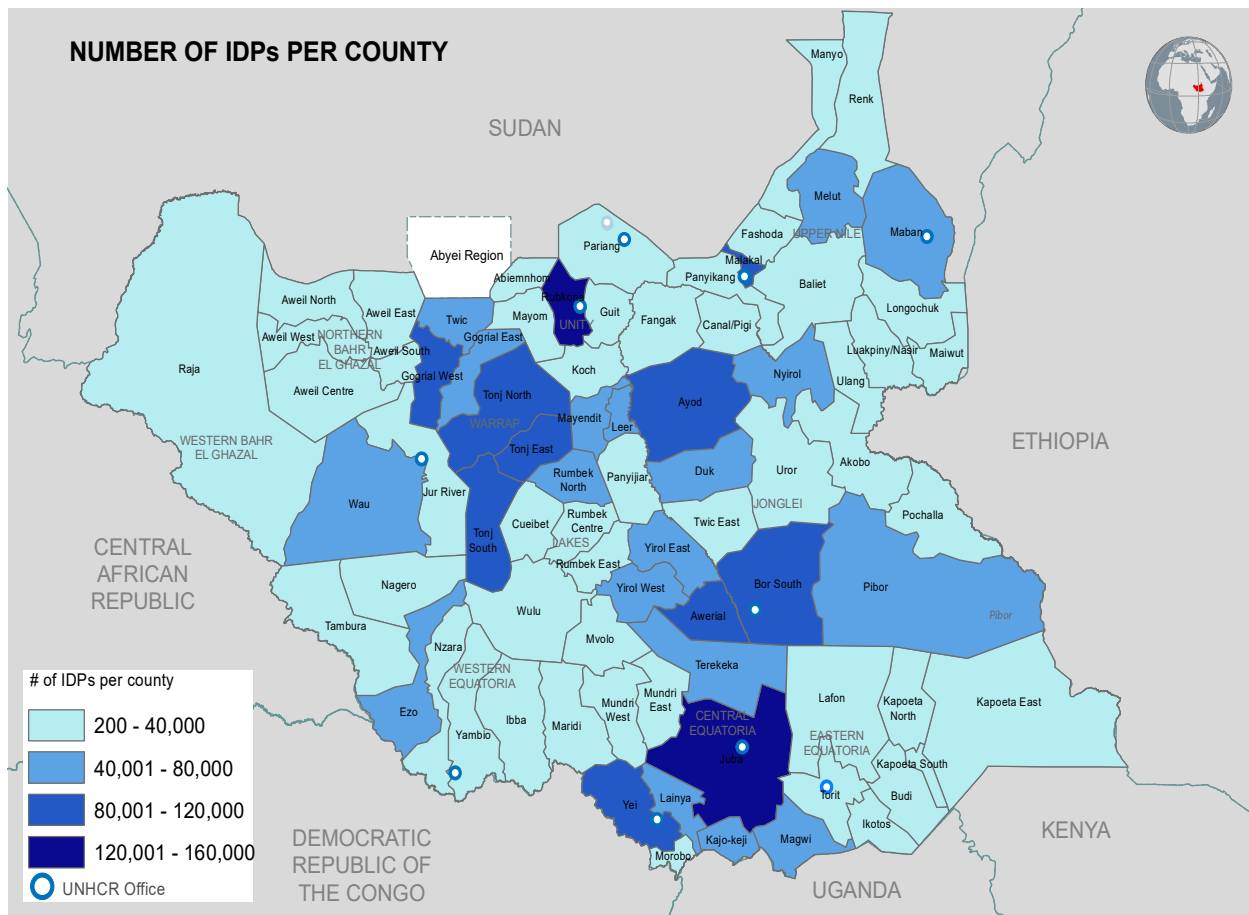


NUMBER OF IDPS BY LOCATION TYPE
