- 175 active sites (50%) with 19K individuals

=> 689 individuals

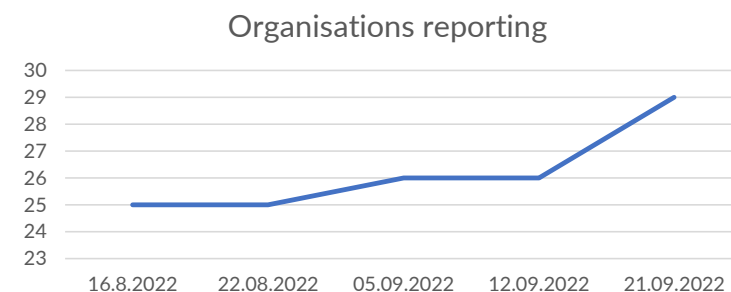
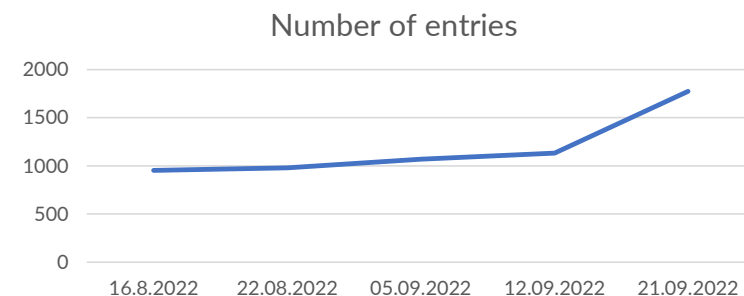

 1. Timeline
 2. Completed/ Update Set of Indicators => After inputs from sectors and Working Groups
 3. Common Baseline : preliminary data from MSNA and protection profiling, any other assessments that can be shared with humanitarian community, in order to provide a common basis for planning assumptions
4. Programming information from each partner (what, where, when, for whom, costs) defined by sector of intervention

2023 population planning figures

- Winterization to continue (Q1 and Q4) and outflows related to fuel shortages, inadequate shelter
- Inflation and fuel costs will also impact host communities: the overall assistance will be reduced/limited
- Return will continue to be pendular if the hostilities continue at their current level. Hostilities are not anticipated to decrease significantly
- Large outflows will increase in case of escalated conflict
- ?
