Update on indicator selection for RRP needs overview, calculation of people in need (PIN)

At the moment, sector leads are in the process of selecting relevant indicators from relevant assessments for use in the 2023 RRP process. These will inform the needs overview, and the IMWG team is supporting with calculation of sectoral people in need figures (PIN). For this calculation, data on those indicators (for example, % of refugees having problems related to water facilities access) will be combined with total number of refugees in Moldova. This is important for everyone because it will be directly tied to the project submission stage: Sector leads will be asking members to submit projects, and keep in mind that submitted projects cannot collectively cover more than the calculated PIN for that sector.

This process for the 2023 RRP will enable a focused response that targets the most vulnerable to meet their needs.

Teodora: Are the indicators fixed once they have been selected by sector leads or is this flexible?

Yurii: We start with fixed indicators for the 2023 RRP, but we will be able to revise it in following strategic planning exercises and reviews. Also, with this flexibility in mind, we can collectively ensure going forward that assessments coming in 2023 are planned in time to most effectively support strategic planning, such as arranging for the MSNA to be conducted close to the 2024 RRP planning.
