1. Presentation of Virtual Humanitarian Aid Platform (VHAP) by ACTED

The VHAP was introduced and presented by Dustin ACHGILL, ACTED Programme Coordinator. Under UNHCR, ACTED has created a Virtual Humanitarian Assistance Platform, which can be used to centralize the information of all partners' NFI stock in Moldova. Please see the slides below for an outline, and the link for more details. Partners are highly encouraged to engage to forward this request to relevant logistics personnel who should contact Clara and Dustin to arrange a brief tutorial next week. A more complete picture of current NFI stocks will greatly improve the efficiency of preparation for winterization NFI support, will avoid duplication, will identify critical gaps, and address current issues that exist with linking needs to provision if seen as useful to collectively utilize VHAP's request/dispatch feature in the future.

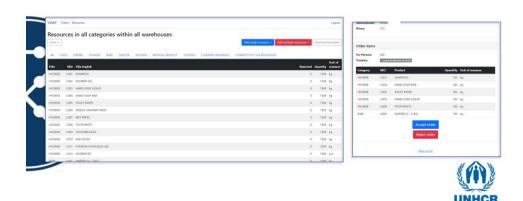


The Virtual Humanitarian Aid Platform is:

- Now: A live database which can include available stock of all partners in Moldova.
- Potential: A tool to link supply to need, dispatching humanitarian aid across the country.

VHAP: Why?



With partners' stock uploaded to VHAP:

It will be possible at a glance to compare the total inventory against the expected needs already calculated for Moldova in order to identify gaps available for partners to fill.



While maintaining full autonomy of your stock, sharing it to the platform also gains you further visibility and reach through requests coming through the platform.

Given the utility of identifying winter contingency in particular, having your inventory uploaded by Oct 28th would allow for a factsheet to be produced and shared with partners in the first week of November, mapping gaps between the expected needs and current stock.
