<p>Agenda Point 1</p> <p>Operational updates by members</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>ACTED</u> – continues to support refugees, providing 17 RACs with hot meals daily and 4 RACs with vouchers. From 13th of October ACTED have started to assist one new RAC ID44. • <u>HelpAge</u> – continues to support refugees, providing 3 hot meals daily in 27 accredited RACs (23 RACs - catering and 4 RACs - vouchers). Two new RACs, one from Chisinau and one from Balti have been taken over. The catering from Cahul was changed due to some issues in these two RACs with food distribution. • <u>Solidarites</u> - continues to provide food assistance (3 meals/day/person) in 6 RACs (1 of them is an accredited one). The number of beneficiaries is around 150 per day. • <u>Peace Winds Japan</u> – provides food assistance to the NCUM Center, which is a National Congress of Ukrainian people in Moldova, but this is a private RAC which is not in the number of 69 operating RACs. Peace Winds provides food assistance with about 2000 food packages (not hot meal) per week at the Patria Lukoil Center, it is aiming for those living outside of RACs. • <u>AAH</u> - provides food assistance - hot meals outside of the RACs and currently continue their assistance in Palanca. They are exploring the possibility to do it as well (with snacks) in Otachi. They plan to start food distribution, probably happen next month, this will be in Balti. • <u>Hope4love</u> – is operating in the country for the last 20 months, and since the beginning of the conflict for the last nine months they've been bringing food on an ongoing basis. The registration of the NGO has been formalized now opened a brand new facility in Chisinau that can house over 1000 pallets. They are initiating a sustained program of bringing truckloads of food. The initial plan is to distribute seven days ration packs for displaced population as well as RACs. Agenda Point 3 Updates on 3RP sector consultations and next steps	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The exercise is going on and the sectors were asked to convene and organize consultation to identify targets indicators and objectives of each sector and indicate also the needs for within the scope of this response plan. On the 10th of October ATWG has arrange this consultation including FS and WASH WGs. • The form for project submission for 3RP will be circulated by IA coordination team with the deadline of 22 October 2022. 	. Agenda Point 4 AOB	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The winterization plan, which has been recently published by the IA coordination team. The targeted refugee population is 130,000, which includes refugees 90,000 currently already in Moldova and expected 40,000 refugees to come during the winter. It also includes 92,000 host communities among vulnerable Moldovans living in the areas hosting refugees, to ensure the social cohesion. The total budget of this appeal is around USD 44M, of which USD 35M is already secured by different organizations.
