Update on recent developments that took place at PBS	<p>Palanca bus-station:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On Monday 29 August 2022, 61 refugees transported by GLORIA were received at PBS. The Field team had the chance to talk to Anna, the head of the GLORIA organization, to find out how they operate, how they organize people for evacuation and how they keep track of the people transported. • Coordination continues between the UNHCR Field Team in Palanca and Be & Angel. On Friday 2 September 2022, 1 bus with 43 refugees were received at PBS. No special requests were received, and no one needed special assistance. They remained at PBS for about 20 minutes, until they ate and then left. • On 30 August the food storage container for Volunteers was received at PBS and was installed next to the old one used by them. • On 30 August the Field team received 7 wheelchairs from UNHCR's office. • The Field Team in Palanca continues to maintain presence at the BCP Palanca and Tudora border. • On Monday 29 August, the Palanca team met with Nancy Bocskor and Lee Peterson. Nancy Bocskor came from the USA and is working with the PM's office and is a great supporter of Moldova and UNHCR, she was with her colleague Lee Peterson. The Field team met them and show the PBS and Palanca BCP, explaining to them all the work done. • 05.09 a bus from GLORIA with 49 people transported to Romania with IOM and 10 to Chisinau with ACTED • 6.09 1 bus from Be an Angel for overnight with 51 people instead of 120 that we have been waiting for. • 7.09 meeting with Inter agency and local NGOs • 05.09 Han Ho Jin, director of the Se Jong Center for Korean Culture and Language and representatives of the South Korean Embassy visited PBS. • 05.09.2022 OSCE representatives from Border management visit PBS, they are monitoring the situation in all Moldova and also Transnistria for the security and humanitarian help. • Yesterday we met a delegation from Don Bosco foundation "jugend eine welt" that shelters refugees • Today we have the BBC channel here and also received the visit from Directorate-General for European Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid Operations from European Commission and Embassy of EU. 	

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Temporary Protection project is in the process of being created, it will provide easier access for refugees at the stage of entering the country, it will also facilitate access to services available for refugees on the territory of the Republic of Moldova. 	
General updates from all organizations on activities at PBS.	<p>Molova For Peace – no updates</p> <p>Intersos: activity is going well, the team continues to provide services in their area of activity. There is a need for warm clothes for children for the cold season.</p> <p>UNFPA - presence is ensured at BCP and PBS, mobile team located in Cahul. UNFPA colleagues inform us that on Friday 09.09.2022 some UNFPA donors will visit PBS.</p> <p>IGSU- There are no updates, we continue to monitor the situation and work with each organization.</p> <p>IsraAid has not been active on the territory for some time, the work of IsraAid colleagues is stopped but we have not been informed about this.</p> <p>Also, sensitive cases that need extra attention will require the involvement of the Causeni psychiatrist to determine how critical the case is.</p> <p>IOM - No challenges. We are facing any situation, our activity continues as normal.</p> <p>UNFPA - will provide warm clothing for young children during the cold season, but these sets, which include warm clothing, will be available in winter.</p> <p>IGSU - suggests to provide material aid not only to children from Ukraine but also to vulnerable local families to avoid competition. Because children from vulnerable families are upset that children in Ukraine are given things but local ones - not.</p> <p>ACTED – No Updates.</p> <p>We are in contact with Gloria, and we are ready to help people coming from Ukraine who need transportation in the directions we cover. For the month of August, we have provided support with transport 1500 passengers.</p> <p>CDA- No updates. We monitor and continue to provide legal assistance to people coming from Ukraine.</p> <p>Solidarites- We are continuing to distribute kits for families and mothers with children, at the moment we are looking for solutions to face the cold period of the year.</p>	More information regarding the activity of each of the organisations.
