<p>Update on recent developments that took place at PBS</p>	<p>UNHCR:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On 6 October 2022, the Head of the Moldovan Border Police Rosian Vasilo, accompanied by the Head of the Lithuanian Border Guard Service Rustamas Liubajevas, visited the BCP Palanca. They also visited the PBS, where the Field team met them and gave a presentation of the area and explained everything to them. • On 06 October 2022, the 2 tents planned for the contingency and the tent for IOM staff, the Volunteers and for refugees, were set up at the BCP in Palanca. 1 - 3x3 tent was installed at the entrance of the Palanca customs and another tent consisting of 2 - 6x10 tents, joined together, was installed on the portion of the road at the entrance to Moldova. The walls of the tents, that remained uninstalled, were stored at the PBS. • On Thursday, 06 October 2022, a bus with 38 passengers from Zaporojie, Mykolaiv and Kharkiv transported by Be an Angel arrived at PBS during the night. The field team together with colleagues from PBS met them, assisted and supported them. The people stayed for overnight in the tent camp where they received hot food provided by the volunteer's team. • On 7 October, 10 electric oil heaters were brought to Palanca. They were stored in the storage container at PBS. • On 9 October, the field team, together with other colleagues from PBS, received 48 people transported from Be an Angel, 17 of whom were children. No special assistance was needed. • On the same day, 9 October, the Field team received 55 people transported by Hope & Faith. The people were accommodated in Cebalaccia and then left for Germany, ACTED informed us. • On 10 October, the Field team, together with other colleagues from PBS, received 62 people transported by Gloria. They were directed to Romania. 	<p>Activities that took place during the week</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 11 October, 68 refugees were received at PBS transported by Be an Angel. They spent the night in the tent camp where they received hot food and all necessary assistance. • On 11 October, the Mobile team will visit the following villages: Stefan Voda. 	
<p>General updates from all organizations on activities at PBS.</p>	<p>IGSU: at the moment, thermal insulation work is being carried out on the systems in the sanitary units The works nearby, the gravel pavilion for the car park is finished as well as its fencing. Given that the actions of the AU are critical, we should expect a greater influx of Ukrainian citizens. I advise you to inform yourself from trusted news sources.</p> <p>CDA: Continue to provide legal services at PBS and BCP. I inform you that there are 3-4 asylum applications per day. Asylum applications are requested not only by men but also by women and children. We are starting a project at the airport in chisinau, so we are available there too.</p> <p>Acted: We offer our services as usual, I inform you that from Palanca 550 people were transported in September. In October so far, 200 people have been transported At the moment the sim-card stocks are out of stock.</p> <p>Intersos: There are not many updates, work continues at PBS, sensitive cases are solved according to protocol, continue to provide assistance to people with disabilities.</p> <p>IOM: The team has been replaced by 2 local staff members who started work on Monday. Since the beginning of the month, 200 passengers have been transported from PBS Today 25 representatives from the IOM visited PBS to visit and see the operation here.</p> <p>Helvetas: There are no changes in our activity, soon there will be a tent on the entrance side of the country.</p> <p>Blue Dot: no updates, normal operation, no unusual incidents. I would like to inform you that 419 children and 346 adults have been registered as having benefited from our services here at PBS For October 114 children and 119 adults received Blue Dot services at PBS.</p> <p>IsraAid: We are resuming work at PBS, with a 2 member on rotation for 7 days a week. in the container we have child friendly spaces but also resting spaces for pregnant women and the old people.</p> <p>GSS: GSS activity is already 24/24 so it is necessary to urgently connect to electricity the space where the security is located.</p>	<p>Informing all actors about their activity at PBS</p>

	<p>Moldova for Peace: work is proceeding normally without incident, continue to support people in finding accommodation.</p> <p>IGSU (person responsible for the tent camp): Since the beginning of the tent camp activity, 7646 people have passed through, of which 5280 have been accommodated. At the moment 8 people are accommodated. A person can stay in the tent camp for 72 hours. cases where there are mentally ill people are the responsibility of the social worker.</p> <p>Solidarites International: The thermal insulation of the sanitary groups is in process since the beginning of the week. We want to supply drinking water to the tents camp, as well as the disinfection of the tents with the organization of the washing of the laundry there.</p> <p>UNFPA: work continues without incidents that should be reported. We made some changes in the package of goods offered to mothers with children, so we replaced the powder detergent with liquid detergent.</p>	
AOB	<p>Suggestions: The need to report registration numbers of buses carrying passengers, there are suspicions that they are not regular routes, thus, they should register with the state structures that approve these trips, moreover, maybe they are with refugees who need some services that we can offer them</p>
