Update on recent developments that took place at PBS	<p>UNHCR:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On October 19th, 2022, the IFRC, UNDSS and WFP visited PBS; On the same day, during the coordination meeting, the Inter-agency and A&T Units provided updates regarding the SOPs for PBS and the relative annexes for the workflow and service mapping. • On October 21st, 2022, UNHCR staff conducted a FGD in Palanca with adult refugees. • On October 24th, the field team in Palanca together with INTERSOS in the late night met the Team Humanity minibus at the Tudora border. There were 19 refugees (8 women, 2 men, 9 children) transported. • On October 25th, 53 people were transported by the organization House of Hope and Faith. They were transported to Cebalaccia by ACTED and from there they left for Germany with Space Eye. • On October 26th, we are waiting to receive 57 people transported by Be an Angel. They will stay for overnight in the tent camp. • Tomorrow, October 27th, the Mobile team together with Intersos and CDA colleagues will visit Ermoclia. 	Activities that took place during the week
General updates from all organizations on activities at PBS.	<p>ACTED: informed about their continuous support to refugees by transporting them, although there has been seen a decrement in the requests (about 2-3 people per day); in addition, the team focuses and allocates their resources for providing transport to the accommodated refugees within the Moldexpo RAC. As it will be closed soon, the team transports refugees all over the country. Also, there were prepared to be distributed around 2000 flyers in Ukraine regarding ACTED's transport services. There are not major requests for transportation to Germany.</p> <p>IsrAid: there are not major updates.</p>	Informing all actors about their activity at PBS

UNFPA: the team provided a range of different services such as first aid, psycho-social and information support to about 210 refugees. The breakdown is the following:

- Teenager – 20;
- Elderly person – 29;
- Lactating woman – 12;
- Pregnant woman – 6.

Blue Dot: 128 children and 94 adults were provided with assistance.

GSS: no major updates, except for the security cabs which have been connected to the electricity.

ACR: the volunteers continue regularly to provide hot meals and drinks for refugees arriving at both Palanca Bus Station and the Tent Camp.

Moldova for Peace: No major updates

IOM: the team met the volunteers from Bucuresti in order to better understand how the transported refugees from the Palanca Bus Station arrive in Romania. There is a domoha.go.ro site where refugees can register in order to have access to the different available services such as accommodation, transportation, etc; in addition, a family of 36 people from Costesti were transported to Romania; IOM doctors are well equipped for the emergencies and are available all the time.

CDA: is providing legal advice at the Palanca BCP, BS, Chisinau airport and in the whole country. The team started to help people, including refugees, to register online for additional support on the site compensantii.md; It was observed that people from Tajikistan, Uzbekistan, Armenia are trying to go to Ukraine through Moldova and then to the EU countries, after being provided with documents that affirm they were living in Ukraine since the war started.

IGSU (Tent Camp): there were registered 50 people, while 44 have been accommodated for 1 overnight.

IGSU PBS: met the Colonel Efras to discuss about connections and mechanisms of humanitarian aids abuses. There are people coming from Ukraine and going back while benefiting several times from the humanitarian aids; Asked all the present actors to save the electricity in the context of the recent decisions taken by the Moldovan authorities.

Concordia: informed that a total of 120 places are available within their RACs in Causeni, Chisinau and other locations. However, the RACs are not accredited; There will be alimentary kits distribution in Tudora in the upcoming days.

Intersos: Intersos medical team informed that their doctor will stop offering their services at the Palanca BS, as there are not many requests and the medical staff is not prepared for the emergencies cases. Therefore, it was decided to reallocate their resources in places with higher demand. The decision was taken together with the Ministry of Health and WHO. They will maintain the medical container at the Palanca BS and will follow up with the field staff to understand if the demands will increase and, in that case, they may return. Also, drugs without prescriptions will be remained in the container available.
