Update on recent developments that took place at PBS	<p>UNHCR:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On 26 October, the field team received 57 people transported by Be an Angel. They stayed overnight in the tented camp and the next day continued their journey to Chisinau. • On 27 October, the Mobile team together with Intersos and CDA colleagues visited Ermoclia, where they met with refugees, talked and informed them about the services available to them. • On 27 October, the field team received 10 people transported by Be an Angel at PBS. They stayed until they ate and then left for Chisinau. • On 28 October, the field team received a delegation from IOM consisting of Andrea APOSTU - DG NEAR (Directorate-General for Neighborhood and Enlargement Negotiations) policy officer, Margo BAARS Cara - IOM Emergency Coordinator, Shihab ALKAIRAWAN - Head of Operations, who visited Palanca bus station. • On 1 November, we received 67 people transported by the Gloria organization, they stayed until they ate and then continued their journey to Romania and Germany. • On 1 November, the field team received 10 electric heaters and 6 RHUs for BMA. It was not possible to deliver them to the tent camp on the same day because without prior communication and permission from their supervisor the BMA staff could not sign the papers and receive the RHUs. Therefore, it was decided to store them in the white tent at PBS and the field team has the papers to be signed. • Today, 2 November, the field team was supposed to receive 40 people transported by Be an Angel, but then the evacuation was cancelled. General updates from all	<p>IGSU: We received the tent that will serve as a warehouse on the territory at the Causeni IGSU.</p>	

<p>organizations on activities at PBS.</p>	<p>Thanks ACTED for the useful information they provide us from BCP, on the flow of people coming to the PBS.</p> <p>IsraAid: PBS activity continues, the same services are offered to beneficiaries, there are 2 facilitators working in rotation.</p> <p>UNFPA: the distribution of goods to refugees continues, as well as the opening of a new point in the territory where services will be offered to those in need. From last week until today we had 60 beneficiaries The person in charge in the Palanca will be replaced.</p> <p>ACTED: We offer our services as usual, there are no other updates. 700 - people were transported from Palanca to Chisinau. It is necessary to get torches to cope with the darkness, as it gets dark quite quickly.</p> <p>IOM: Work is proceeding normally without incident, continue to support people with transportation. 600 people were transported this week.</p> <p>Moldova for Peace: Work is proceeding normally without incident, continue to support people in finding accommodation. Our presence will be from Monday to Friday, we already do not offer services on weekends</p> <p>GSS: Nothing new to add, everything is monitored, and we operate according to the schedule.</p> <p>Helvetas: There are no changes in our activity.</p> <p>CDA: Continue to provide legal services at PBS and BCP. There are asylum seekers with Russian citizenship, they are accommodated in centers. There are cases when, for unknown reasons, people with Russian citizenship are not allowed to enter Moldova.</p> <p>Intersos: Continue to ensure presence and activity at PBS, there are also employees who provide psychological services at the library in the village of Palanca, and a mobile team is also provided in the territory. Psychological assistance is offered in the House of Culture, as well as activities for children, food is also prepared with them.</p> <p>Solidarites International: We continue to distribute the kits. We consider it necessary to rush things to get the generator for PBS.</p> <p>Blue Dot: no updates, normal operation, no unusual incidents. I would like to inform you that 55 children and 35 adults have been registered as having benefited from our services here at PBS this week.</p>	<p>Informing all actors about their activity at PBS</p>
