

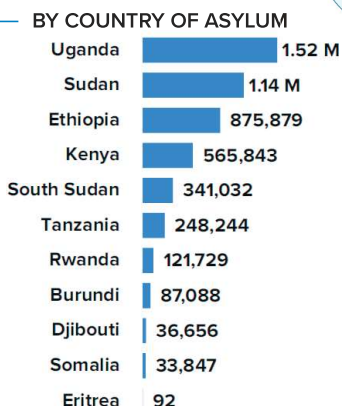

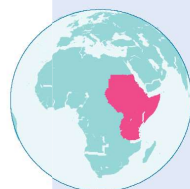

## REGIONAL COVERAGE



UNHCR's Regional Bureau for the East and Horn of Africa and the Great Lakes Region (EHAGL) is located in **Nairobi, Kenya** and covers **11 operations**: Burundi, Djibouti, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Kenya, Rwanda, Somalia, South Sudan, Sudan, Tanzania and Uganda. It currently manages **4 regional situations** (Burundi, Ethiopia, Somalia and South Sudan).






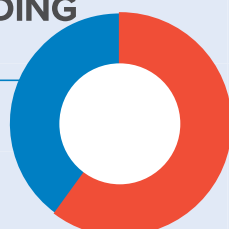

### COVID - 19

**666,735** refugees received at least one vaccine dose in the region.

**12,808** confirmed COVID-19 cases among refugees in the EHAGL region since early 2020, and **165** deaths

**All countries in the EHAGL region have ongoing vaccination campaigns** although vaccine shortages continue to pose a challenge across the region.



### DROUGHT RESPONSE

**1.52 million** priority populations targeted for assistance in Ethiopia, Kenya and Somalia, including 943,000 IDPs and 576,000 refugees

**\$ 42.6 million** overall regional financial requirements, including \$22 million in Ethiopia, \$11.1 million in Kenya and \$9.5 million in Somalia
