

**149,772** REFUGEE RETURNEES IN 2022

The East and Horn of Africa and Great Lakes region is host to some 4.91 million refugees and asylum seekers, the majority (2.20 million) from South Sudan. A further 11.65 million people are internally displaced in the region, as a result of conflict and natural disasters. A total of 8,495 refugees returned to their countries of origin in October 2022.




