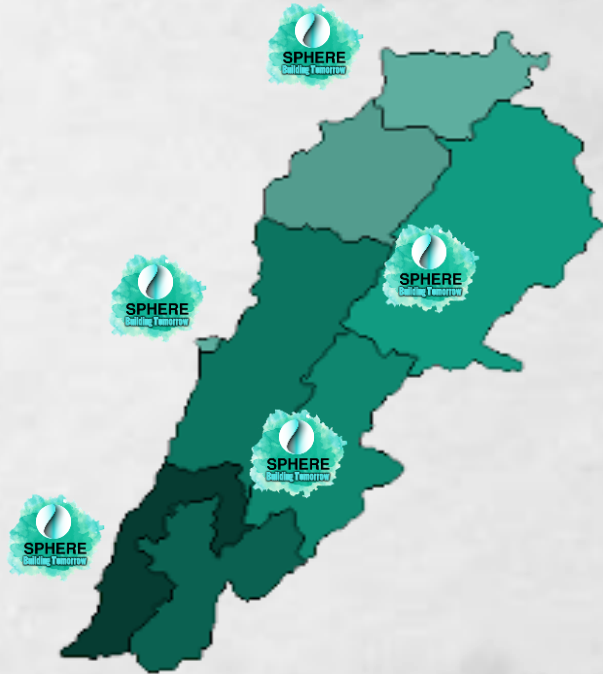

Program Title: Agriculture Livelihood Program –ALP

- Targeted Location:** Across Lebanon.
Project duration: 12 months



Project overview: Stimulate local economic development and market systems by improving livelihood opportunities in the agriculture sector, career development, and life skills to ensure labor-intensive activities by addressing immediate agriculture recovery and assistance and meet basic needs to vulnerable populations: In-kind distribution and access to income/cash.

1. Agriculture Livelihoods Skills
2. Business Development and Life Skills
- 3.OJT & Apprenticeship
- 4.In-Kind Kits Distribution

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

Improved Job readiness among participants through acquiring the relevant agro-food Livelihood and social awareness:	Ensured access to apprenticeship and cash assistance for 10% of the participants and strength 10% of SMEs to ensure economic sustainability.
Reinforce the population's capacities to access agro-food supported by career development knowledge.	Improve food access through cash-based support to sustainable agriculture livelihoods to enhance productivity.
Strengthen capacities to foster dialogue, social cohesion and conflicts sensitivity and preventions.	Stimulate local economic growth and market system to foster income-generating opportunities and decent and safe employment



PROJECT CRITERIA & BENEFITS

The project titled: **"MIN EL ARED FIDI W STAFIDI"** "من الأرض فيدي واستفيدي", addresses up-to-date components with Agro-food and food security sources relevant to each area's settings:

- **Targeted Population: Approx. 20 women (50% of which are refugees and 50% residents).**
 - **Targeted Locations: 5 governorates across Lebanon**
 - **Range of Age: between 17 and 56 years old**
 - **Status: 40% Single, 60% Married, Divorced and Widow**

The women will :

- Benefit from seasonal crop using specific-developed **techniques in Agro-food and food security knowledge.**
- Be supported **with in-kind toolkits**, enabling them to establish small homebased businesses and ensure their livelihoods, and help their families.
- Ensured access to apprenticeship a **cash assistance for 10% of the participants and strength 10% of SMEs to ensure economic sustainability.**

OUTREACH PROCESS

I. An open call addressed will identify to reach out the women from Refugees and host communities' participants in the most appropriate way according to the context and building on their experience.

II. Relative information portals, referral from other NGO's, self-nomination, advertising through flyers and posters, as well refugee and host communities digital and social media platforms.

III. Outreach up to 30 in Beirut and Mount Lebanon:

- 15-20 female vulnerable groups in Mount Lebanon
- 15-20 female vulnerable groups in Beirut

OUTREACH PROCESS

Interested applicants are invited to attend **Info session**, aiming:

- Present the project mission, objectives, activities
- Register and allow for a local community engagement
- Analyze, assess and identify the **15-20 targeted and eligible vulnerable females in Beirut and Mount Lebanon** throughout **vulnerability assessment on ODK application.**
- Confirm registration of women meeting the vulnerability
- Confirm and approve the consent notes and regulations

Two graduation ceremonies in the Beirut and Mount Lebanon at the end of the training execution for all participants with certificates distribution

Distribute 30 In-Kind Kits, packages including infrastructural items and tools relevant to Beirut and Mount Lebanon components.

- 15 Agro tools in Beirut
- 15 Soap tools in Mount Lebanon

To ensure self-income and start-up business opportunities in agriculture and encourage in-house production whether home-business or start-up business adaptable to their proper eco-system.

APPRENTICESHIP & CASH ASSISTANCE SUPPORT

Participants:

Assess and secure **10% of the female for apprenticeship in Beirut & Mount Lebanon:**

- 2 selected females from Beirut
- 2 selected female from Mount Lebanon

The apprenticeship criteria are:

- Highly committed and mostly in need for apprenticeship training to acquire cash for career opportunities to Ability to attend 5 times per week
- Achieve 6 hours per day.

SME

Strength **10% of small scale enterprises in Beirut and Mount Lebanon:**

1 to 2 SME will be supported to ensure their sustainability at the same time (Field of Agriculture and Soaping)

MONITORING & EVALUATION

The M&E mechanism will be applied to evaluate the progress/improvement of the training execution including quantitative and qualitative tools:

- Curriculum components
- Pre-posttest
- Practical activities
- Assignments
- Participants and trainers' attendance sheets
- Appraisal Performance
- Participants Feedback
- Narrative and financial reports

To facilitate to identify the lessons learned and take efficient corrective actions. This is to be applicable within

COMMUNICATION & VISIBILITY

- Visual materials will include indoor tools (**banners, documents, visual presentation**) with the partners logos on all items.
- All the training sessions and practicum will be covered with **photos and videos** based on designed Visibility Plan.
- This process will be sustaining the transparency and credibility in front of **donors, partners, partners, and beneficiaries.**
