1.	Introduction	Meeting started with opening remarks by the co-chairs and introduction of the participants. Primero and the registration process that was launched six weeks ago.	
2.	Operational updates	Yesterday UNICEF had over 5000 children registered in Primero from all over the country, counties with higher number over 100 registered are: Constanta and Vaslui, Suceava and Iasi with over 300 cases and Bucharest sector 2, Brasov, Maramures, Timis with over 200 cases. Regarding registration people encountered several problems: they collected all people addresses from NGOs and local authorities, but	Before the end of September, a discussion on primero to re-adjust or raising additional support on this exercise. 		<p>They started to call in advance and ensure themselves that the trip in the location is not done without a meaning. There is no real time monitoring of the youths of the locations declared to the local authorities.</p> <p>Terre des hommes continues to distribute educational and hygiene kits, it's not always clear what always needed.</p> <p>They continued their work in centers (MHPSS activities).</p> <p>Q: It is possible to identify individuals who are signed up for cash assistance?</p> <p>A: We will double check. The use of Primero is based on the method that has in the first step the identification process, in this process, lists were developed by the child protection authorities on a county level, based on the formal requests addressed to all institutions and organizations who are active within the respective county.</p> <p>The institutions providing cash would have been on the list.</p> <p>The second step used – snowball method.</p> <p>It is only the address collected (without names) to avoid issues regarding personal data protection.</p> <p>Oxfam are implementing through partners.</p> <p>Q: The Child protection referral pathway has been developed?</p> <p>A: We discussed with National and Child protection authorities that case management is organized by the public authorities in partnership with NGOs. CP authorities do not have the capacity to respond to all requests and therefore in some areas they did partnerships with NGOs.</p>
