STORIES OF INTERIORIZATION

Mariangel arrived in Brazil with two children, her sister, and her niece. Not been able to count with a support network, she accessed an emergency shelter in Boa Vista where made contact with the Empowering Refugees initiative.

In addition to the Service and Sales course taught by the National Service of Commercial Learning (SENAC), Mariangel took classes on the Brazilian labor market, laws and labor rights to increase her chances of being hired. As soon as the classes ended, she received a job offer from the Iguatemi shopping mall, one of the companies supporting the project, and was relocated with her family to the countryside of São Paulo.

In its 7th edition, the project promoted the training of 37 women at the Rondon 2 shelter in Boa Vista, between September and October. Also, in this period, it supported the hiring of 37 students and family members in companies such as BRF, Iguatemi, and Sitel. In October, 60 more women were selected for new classes that will take place at the Rondon 2 and Pricumã shelters, 20 of which are part of the group of refugees with disabilities, chronic diseases or who are the only providers for people with disabilities.

I feel good because I'm an empowered woman. A woman who can fight and give everything to her children, work, and who does not have to depend on someone else.

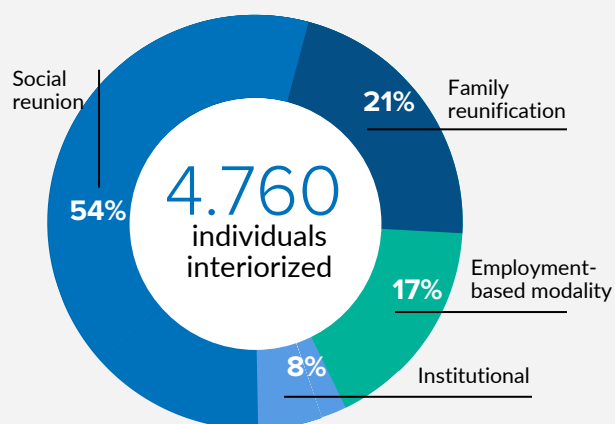

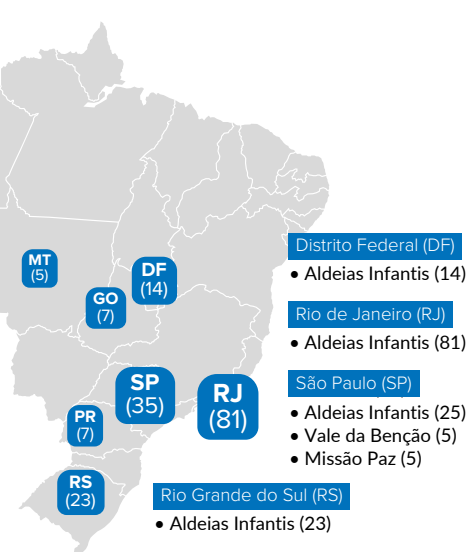

On 29 September, the Rondon 5 Interiorization Center celebrated its first year of operation. To mark the date, AVSI, UNHCR partner that manages the space, promoted along with the community dance presentations, a spa day and recreation activities for children. Since its inauguration in September 2021, 7,543 people have passed through the Relocation Center awaiting a travel opportunity.

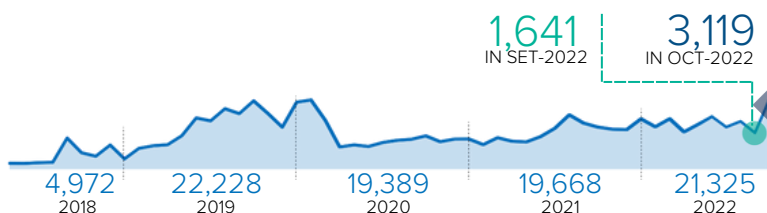
2,443 people welcomed in the emergency shelters of Boa Vista were interiorized, of which **1,176** were from the Rondon 5 Interiorization Center

Overview of the Interiorization Strategy from April 2018 to October 2022

The Federal Government's Interiorization strategy, implemented by Operação Acolhida, voluntarily relocates Venezuelan refugees and migrants from the states of Roraima and Amazonas to other cities in the country.
