




Development of RRP Narrative

inter-Agency Coordination real ministrate with sector leads the inter-sectoral sections of the RRP Narrative for their Review (Situation Overview, Planning Figures, Country Strategy).



### RRP Narrative Sector Specific Section

- Sector Narratives must have max. 2100 characters (approx. 300 words)
- Outline the key country response priorities/areas for the sector.
- Describe in inter-agency neutral language how the planned response will address the different needs of women/men/boys and girls identified and mention specific interventions (what activities, where, for whom), the programmatic and geographical scope.
- Response modalities: explain which response modalities will be used by the sector to deliver assistance based on the different needs identified and to collect sex/age/disability disaggregated data, for example: cash, in-kind, capacity development, etc.
- Include a short reference to the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and the SDGs how the SDGs relate to the sector response, and which SDG(s) the RRP is helping to achieve.
