Update regarding the implementation of the new Guardianship Law (L. 4960/2022): SSPUAM, Aggelika Gyftopoulou (Legal Advisor)	SSPUAM presented the National Guardianship System for unaccompanied children as set by the new L. 4960/2022. The implementation of the law 4960/2022 is expected in the beginning of 2023, as stated by SSPUAM, and the estimated number of 180 guardians are to be recruited for the total population of UAC.
