Updated figures and announcements (UNHCR)	<p><u>2022 RRP Recalibration:</u> Recalibration exercise is over, and all products have been sent to the regional office. Plan is to launch the recalibration through a roundtable event within the RRP countries to present focused shifts on 7th October. A speaker from a local NGO in Romania may be part of the panel in the event.</p> <p><u>2023 RRP Process:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Objectives are ensuring refugees' access to protection and assistance; work towards solutions and social economic inclusion into society; ensuring availability of assistance for people with specific needs; advance social cohesion between refugee and host communities through targeted interventions.• Additional discussion needed to confirm whether 350,000 target population (Ukrainians and TCNs) is realistic for Romania.• Final population figures and budgetary requirements need to be submitted to UNHCR Regional Bureau for Europe by 24 October 2022 in order to be presented at the Humanitarian Summit in New York organized by OCHA. Therefore, below timeline should be met:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- 2023 Kick-off working session with RRP partners including the potential partners 5 October- Potential RRP partners to send interest to appeal 5 to 10 October- Updating sector M&E framework (indicators) by 7 October- Inter-agency sends the budget template (with inclusion of the revised 2023 RRP indicators) to interested RRP partners 10 October- Agency budget and linkage to sector indicator 10 to 20 October

New invitation will be sent. • During the BNWG we will discuss: 1) Presence at Gara de Nord; 2) Need to define covering for the gap of lack of hot meals / in coordination with DSU. • Finalisation of Winterisation Workshop Report with detailed information from partners and further identification / response plan for winter interventions, including field/location. <p><u>Cash Working Group:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discussed the transfer value of cash for winterization and proposed 653 RON/person for the entire winter. • Criteria for winterization cash: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Households with women at risk members / a person with disability / a person with serious medical condition / a child at risk / 4 and more family members / specific legal or physical protection needs - Older-person-headed household with no other adult member (60+ years old) - Single parent households - Unemployed/low-income households <p><u>Child Protection Sub-Working Group:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Next meeting will be on 6 October and then SWG will meet on monthly basis. • SWG Co-Leads will meet with the head of the national child protection authorities in Bucharest to re-engage them in the SWG. <p><u>Protection Working Group:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Will work on updating referral pathways. <p><u>PSEA Network and GBV Group:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 16 Days Activism against Gender-Based Violence global campaign will run from 25 November to 10 December 2022 with the global subject : “UNITE! Activism to end violence against women and girls”. The Campaign is continuing its multi-year theme of Ending Femicide and is also working closely with other Center for Women Global Leadership (CWGL) initiatives to build on the previous multi-year theme on ending GBV in the world of work. • GBV group will have a specific discussion on having a coordinated approach for the 16 Days Activism against Gender-Based Violence during the next meeting. • There will be an in-person PESA ToT on 11 October in Bucharest. Sector Leads are requested to share the info with PSEA focal points and encourage them to attend.
