

## PSEA Network meeting - Romania 27 October 2022, 10.00 - 11.00 (held in hybrid mode)

**Participants:** UNHCR, TdH, WHO, WVI, UNICEF, Plan International, IOM, Salvati Copiii, Amurtel, Patrir, Caritas

## Introductions and Updates from participants

- The new members introduced themselves.
- The PSEA Network lead shared that the first meeting of the government WG on PSEA and Anti-Trafficking would take place on that date and that as per the PSEA Network's Action Plan the emphasis would be on joint advocacy with the CRATTF on the creation of a vetting system for volunteers and for the accommodation scheme.
- Additionally, it was shared that the ToT organized by the PSEA Network successfully took place on the 11<sup>th</sup> of October with 21 participants and co-facilitation by UNHCR, UNICEF and Amurtel.
- UNICEF reiterated the importance of having clarity on the way forward when we receive complaints regarding staff of other/unknown organisations.

## Presentation on the legal framework in case of disclosure of child abuse (Salvati Copiii)

- Salvati Copiii made a presentation on the legal framework that is applicable in case of disclosure of child abuse, including relevant clauses of the L272/2004 on the promotion of children's rights. UNICEF through a partner is working on a relevant program that might be presented in a future meeting.

Presentation of Activity Info (replacing the 5Ws) and opportunity to express interest for the training (UNHCR IMO)

UNHCR Inter-Agency IOM presented the Activity Info system and shared the training opportunity to participate in an 1h online training on the new reporting mechanism.

- A Task Force has been formed with on the Inter-Agency Referrals SOPs with the participation of Konstantina (PSEA Network), Ana Juarez (UNICEF) and Elena Cofaru (TdH)
  - Members to inform Konstantina if they want to participate in the Activity Info training
