Temporary Protection	Presentation on Temporary Protection - Protection Working Group <p>The Republic of Moldova with UNHCR support is discussing protection mechanisms to provide documentation and to strengthen access to rights and services for refugee people in the country. The Temporary Protection will guarantee more stability and local integration for refugees in the country. The government with UNHCR support will maintain updated information/communication on Temporary Protection</p>	
PSEA Training	Inter-Agency Team – PSEA Taskforce <p>PSEA is a key element to be taken into consideration by humanitarian workers and any other actor interacting with the refugees. The sexual exploitation and abuse should be first prevented, and in case it still occurs, it should be stopped at the earliest moment. That is why UNHCR, IOM, and the Inter-Agency Team (PSEA TF) are organizing a PSEA training on the 12th of September and all local NGOs, local</p>	



	<p>authorities' representatives and other partner organizations are invited to participate to the training, so sensitive subjects like sexual exploitation and abuse could be addressed accordingly. CDA and the Municipal government requested to RACs staff to be included in the PSEA trainings as well.</p>	
AoB	<p>Municipal Government of Cahul - Nicolae Dandis, Mayor of Cahul</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Information needs: the government highlighted information needs of available services to refugees' persons living in the city and in villages/rural areas. <p>Winter Season: the government asked support for the winter season, with kits/supplies for refugees and host community. The government also informed fear of losing electricity by the middle of winter because of energy crisis. As follow up action, the government will send a request of help to UN Agencies and the Inter-Agency Team.</p>
