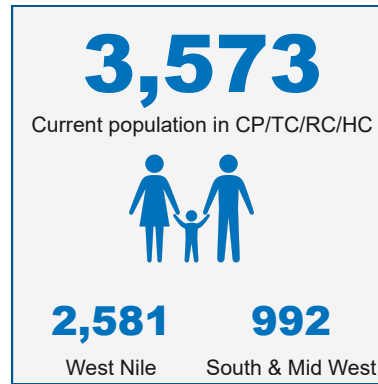


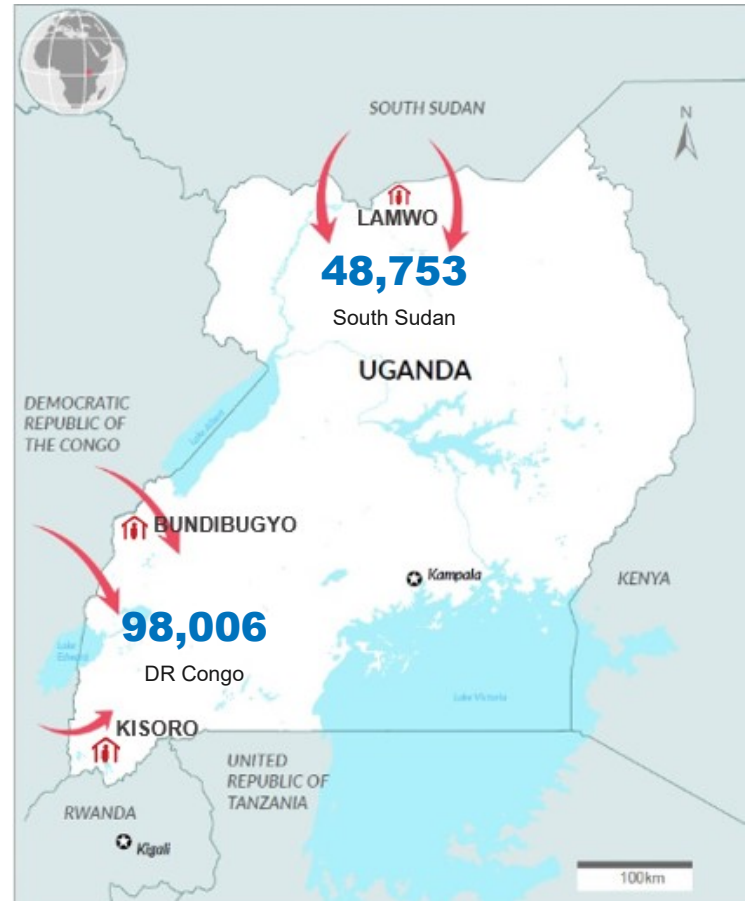
### Key figures and narrative analysis



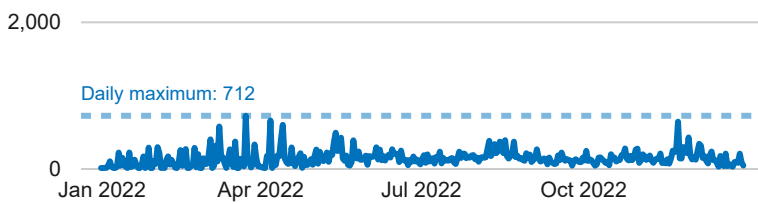
Uganda continues to receive new arrivals from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and South Sudan, through the Southwestern and Northern borders.

There is ongoing conflict in the DR Congo and the situation remains unpredictable.

Note that this dashboard only shows figures for new arrivals who have undergone Level 1 registration, it does not include those who are staying along the border or within the host community.



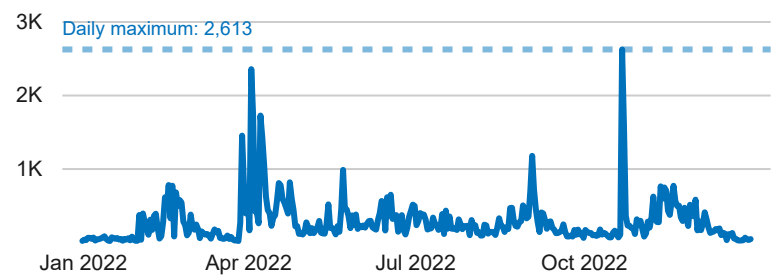
