WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of IDPs decreased from 438,800 last week to 434,900 this week.

In Kayin State, clashes and intensified fighting in Hpapun Township displaced about 30 individuals to Kamamaung town in Hpapun Township.

In Tanintharyi Region, 410 people were displaced within Tanintharyi Township due to armed clashes. However, 2,400 IDPs returned to Launglon Township.

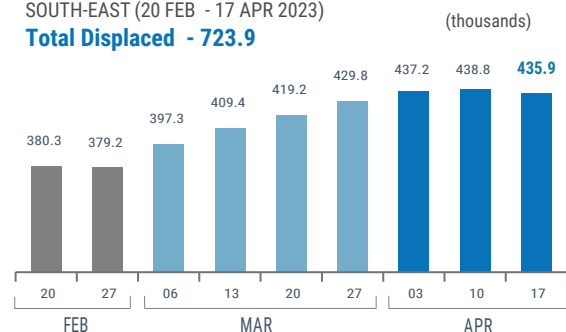
In Shan State (South), 310 IDPs from Loikaw Township were verified to be displaced in Mawkmai Township since late in 2022.

In Bago Region (East), 2,200 IDPs returned to Shwegyin Township following the departure of troops from their villages of origin.

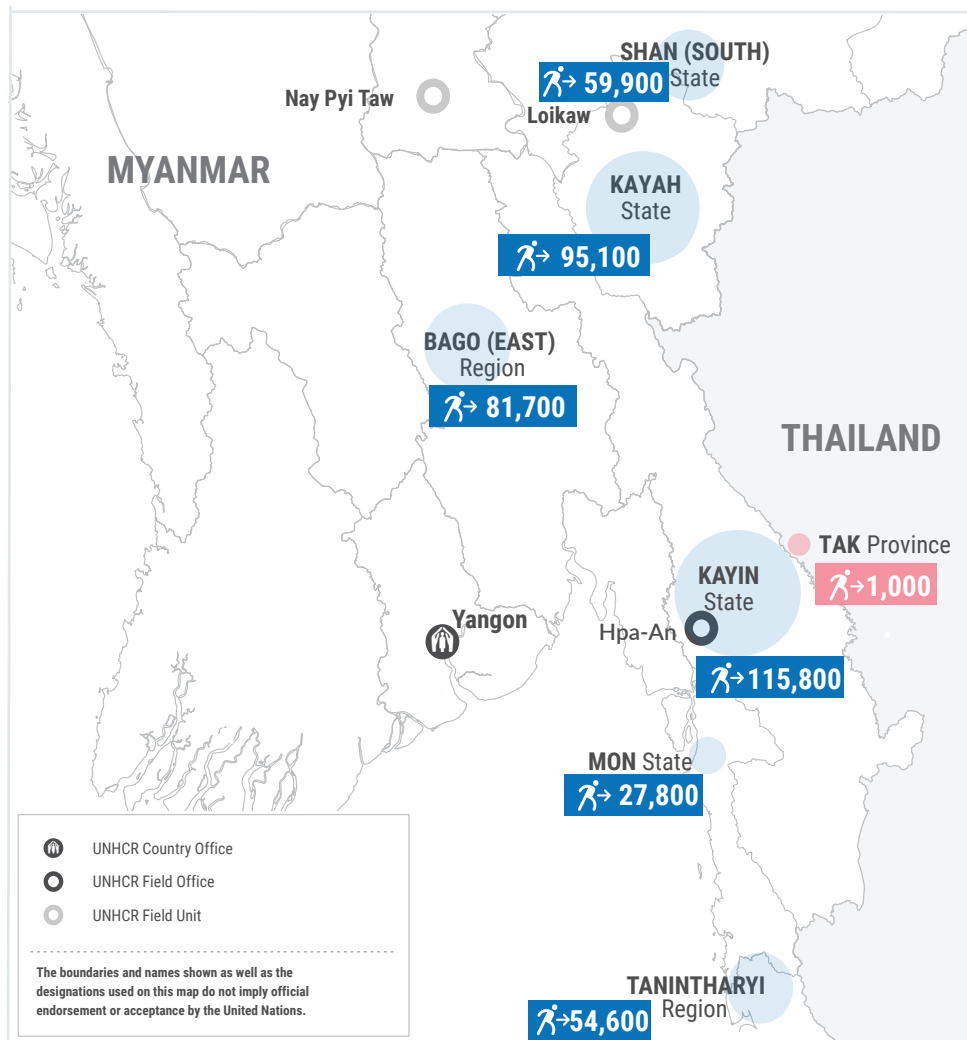
