The WG will keep the meeting with the protection WG, as they have developed an updated work plan and ToRs for 2023 and agreed on the modality of the meetings by having in-person monthly meetings in Zaatari.</p> <p>4. Service providers in the camp are adapting new approaches to enhance the quality of services. For Example, Unicef will start implementing the Girl Shine, in collaboration with UNHCR and trained by IRC. On another note, UN Women will start engaging men and boys in their GBV programs.</p> <p>5.
