WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of IDPs decreased slightly from 440,400 last week to 438,500 this week.

In Kayin State, about 50 IDPs were verified in Hlaingbwe Township, along with about a dozen others in Myawaddy Township. They came from various locations, mostly from Hlaingbwe and Myawaddy Townships, and also from Kyaukkyi, Hpa An, Hpapun, and Bilin in Mon State.

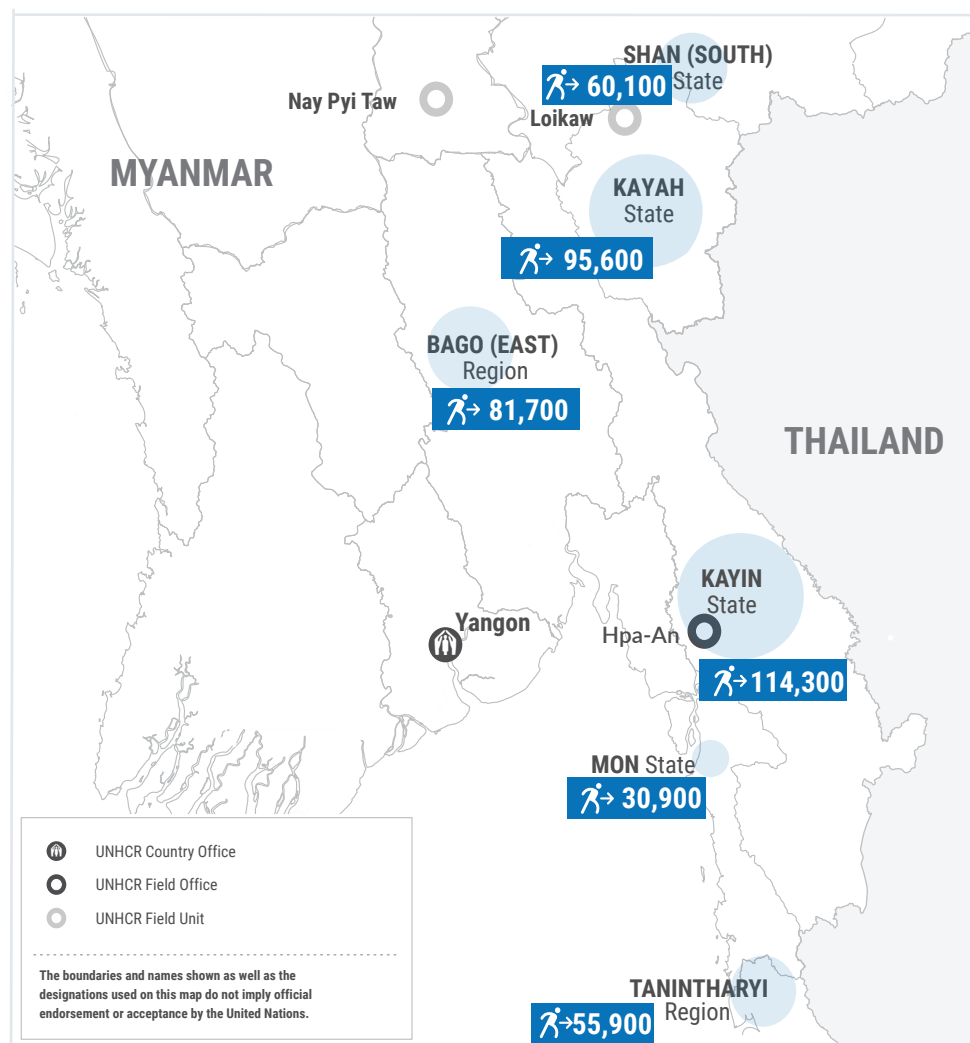
In Shan State (South), about 60 IDPs were verified in Hsihseng Township. They were displaced from Demoso and Nyaungshwe Townships due to intensified fighting, shelling, and airstrikes on 10 April. Additionally, a dozen IDPs were verified as a secondary displacement in Nyaungshwe Township.

In Kayin State, approximately 2,000 IDPs returned to their places of origin in Kyainseikgyi Township during the third week of March 2023.

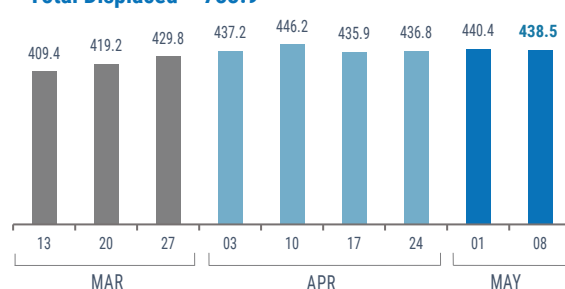

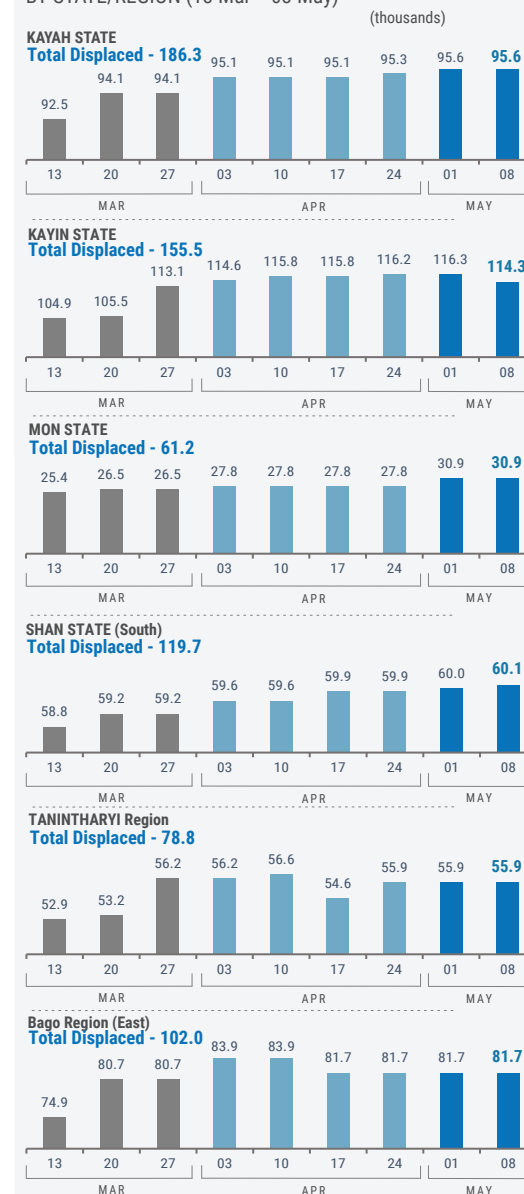
