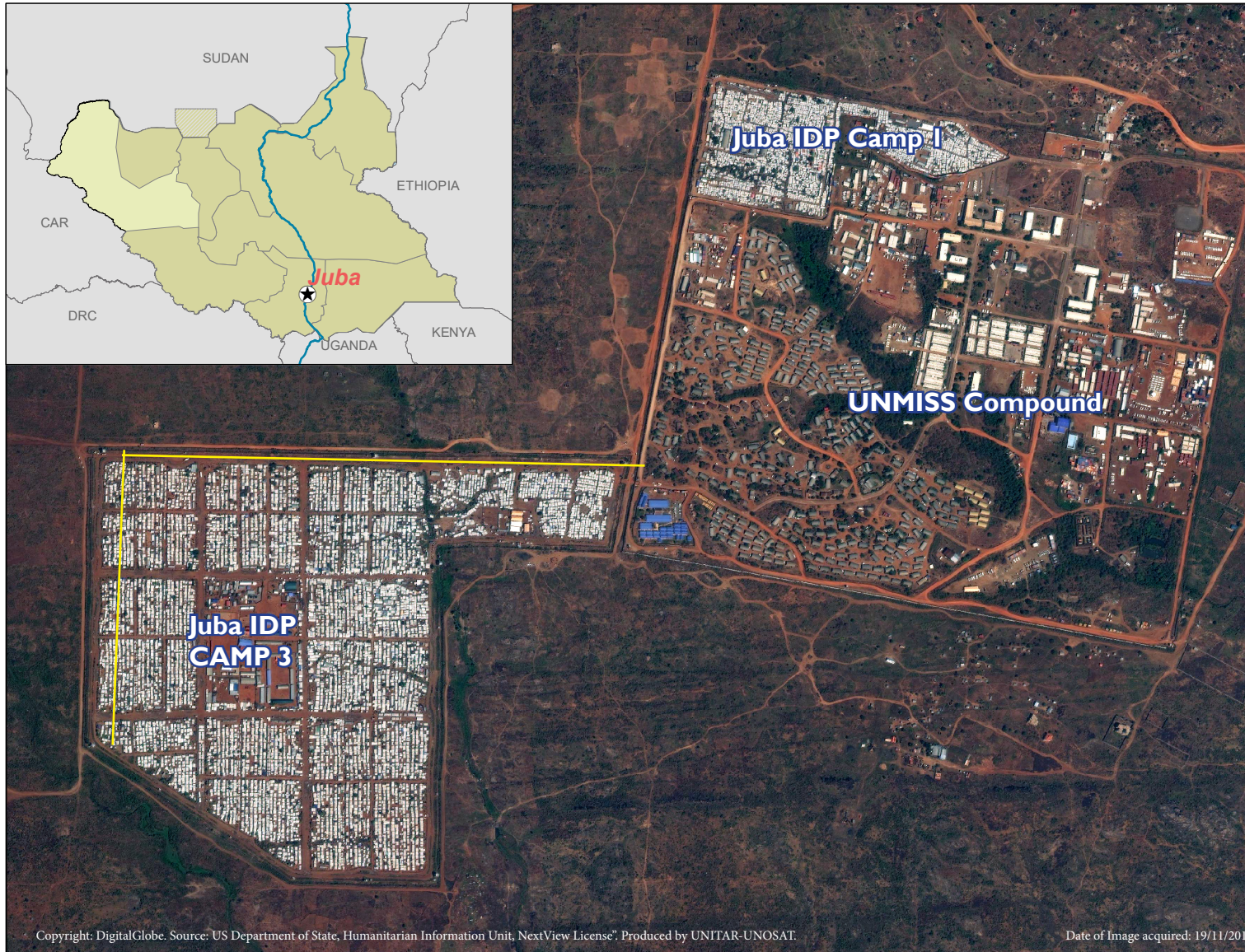
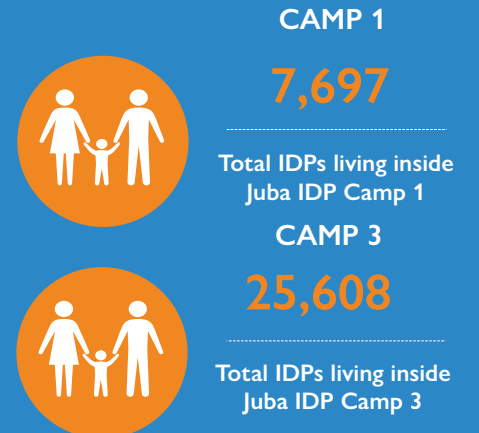


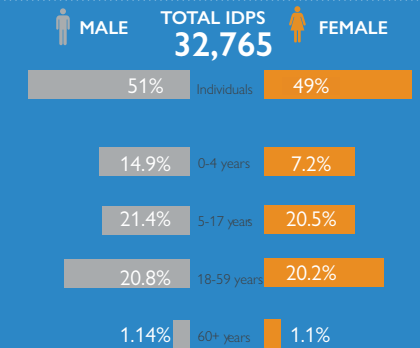

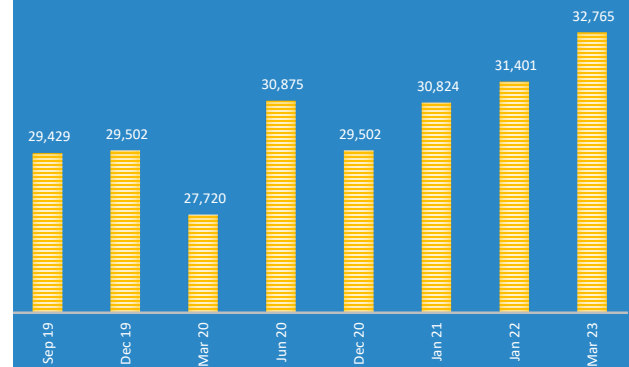
## POPULATION DEMOGRAPHY
