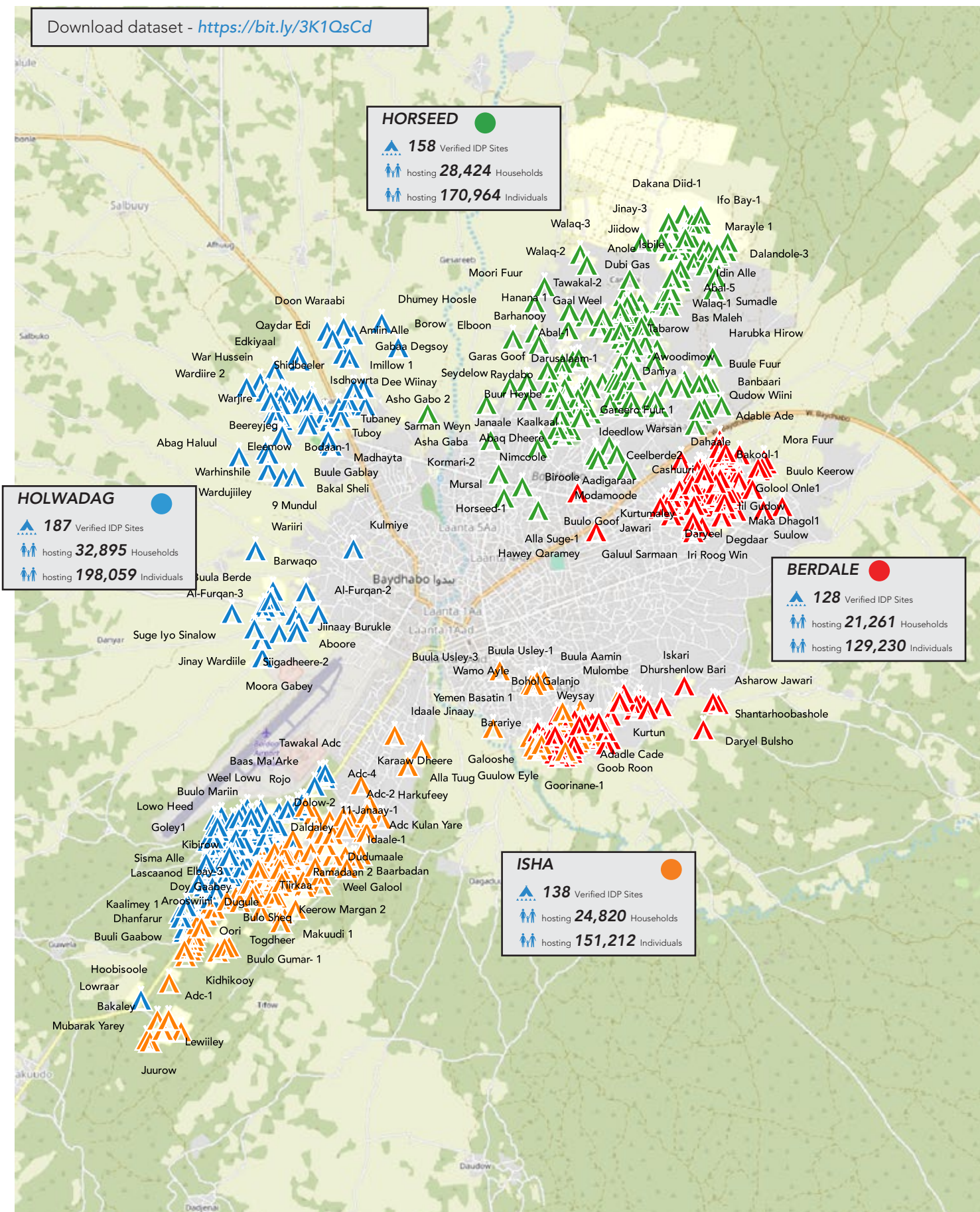

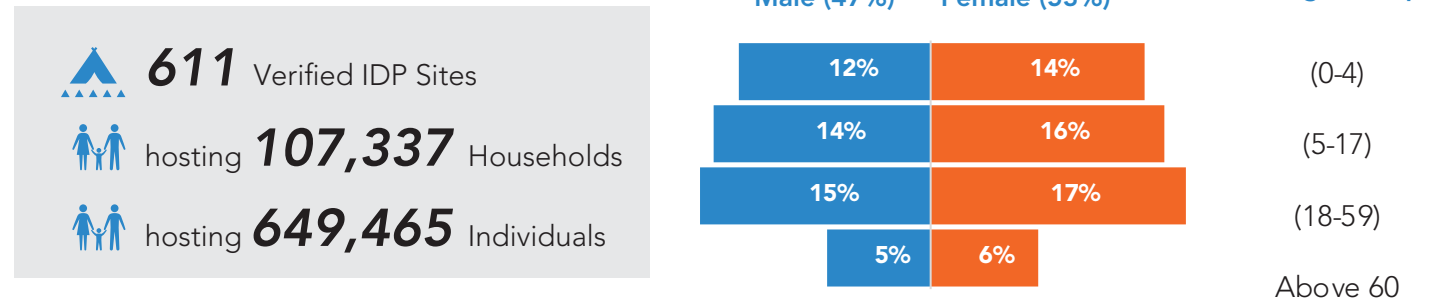


Map of verified IDP sites in Baidoa - February 2023

Assessment overview

A joint IDP site verification exercise was conducted in Baidoa in February 2023. The operation was led by SWSCRI, ACTED, AMARD, CESDO, CWADO, DRC, HINNA, IOM, IRW, Jubba Foundation, MCAN, SCI, READO, Taakulo Somali Community, WWI and UNHCR. 611 IDP sites were identified hosting 107,337 households or 649,465 individuals. Compared to the last site verification conducted in July 2022, there was an increase of 113 IDP sites and 17,861 HH/52,534 individuals. The increase may be attributed to displacements due to the ongoing drought experienced within Somalia.

Eviction Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been issued recently.

13% of IDP sites have been classified as having extreme (9%) and high (5%) risk of eviction

- 68% of sites have landowner authorized occupancy type of tenure
- 82% of sites have agreement in place
- 90% of those that have agreements have written agreements
- 77% of those that have agreements have agreed end dates
- 8% of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months

Flood Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of flooding.

59 IDP sites (10%) have been classified as extreme (always floods) and high (floods frequently)
