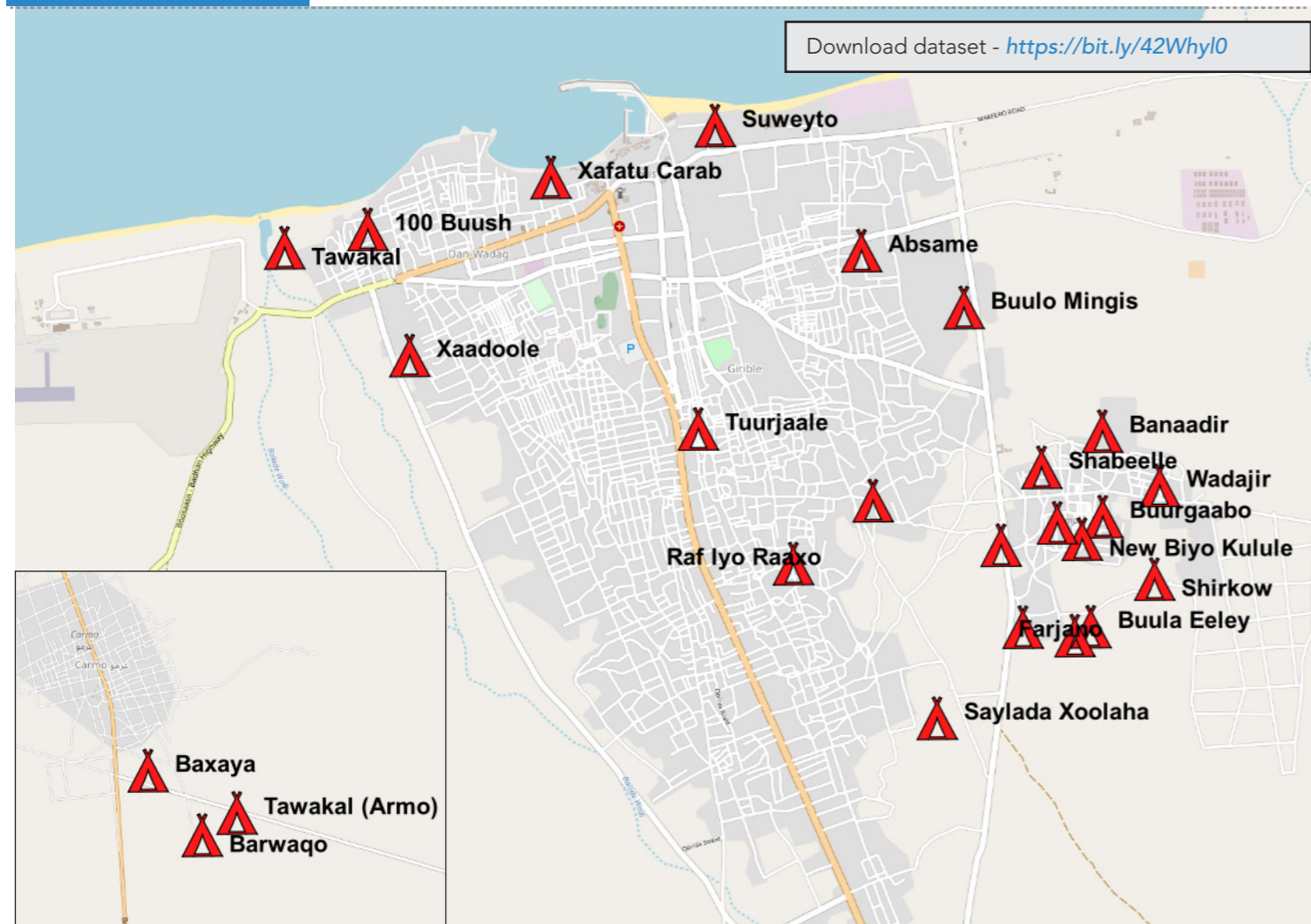


VERIFIED IDP SITES IN BOSSASO AS OF MAY 2023



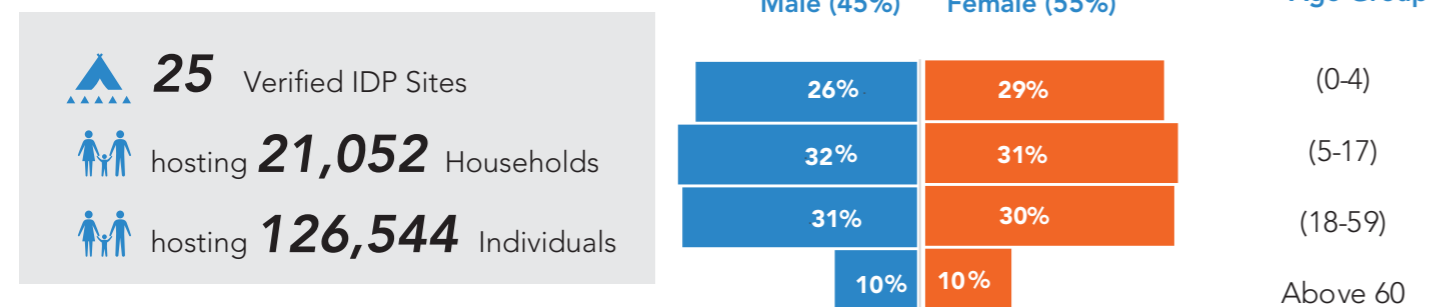
Map of verified IDP sites in Bossaso - May 2023

Assessment overview

An IDP site verification exercise was conducted in Bossaso in May 2023. The operation was led by DRC, NRC, PMWDO, PSA and UNHCR. 25 IDP sites were identified hosting 21,052 households or 126,544 individuals.

Compared to the last site verification conducted in November 2022, there was no increase in sites, a decrease of 1,680 Households but and increase of 2,955 individuals.

Eviction Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been issued recently.

68% of IDP sites have been classified as having extreme (44%) or high (24%) risk of eviction

- 12%** of sites are landowner authorized occupancy
- 60%** of sites have no agreements in place
- 10%** of those that have agreements have oral agreements
- 60%** of those that have agreements have agreed end dates
- 44%** of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months

Flood Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of flooding.

6 IDP sites (24%) have been classified as extreme (always floods) and high (floods frequently)
