

## WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) has slightly increased from 546,400 last week to 552,200 this week.

In Bago Region (East), 572 IDPs from Shwegyi Township were displaced within the Township due to intensified fighting, artillery shelling, and airstrikes.

In Shan State (South), 2,432 IDPs from Loikaw Township, Kayah State were displaced to Nyaungshwe, Pinlaung, and Pekon Townships due to intensified fighting, shelling, and airstrikes. Additionally, 768 people from Pekon Township were displaced within their Township. Among the 3,200 IDPs in Loikaw Township, 1,072 were displaced as a secondary displacement.

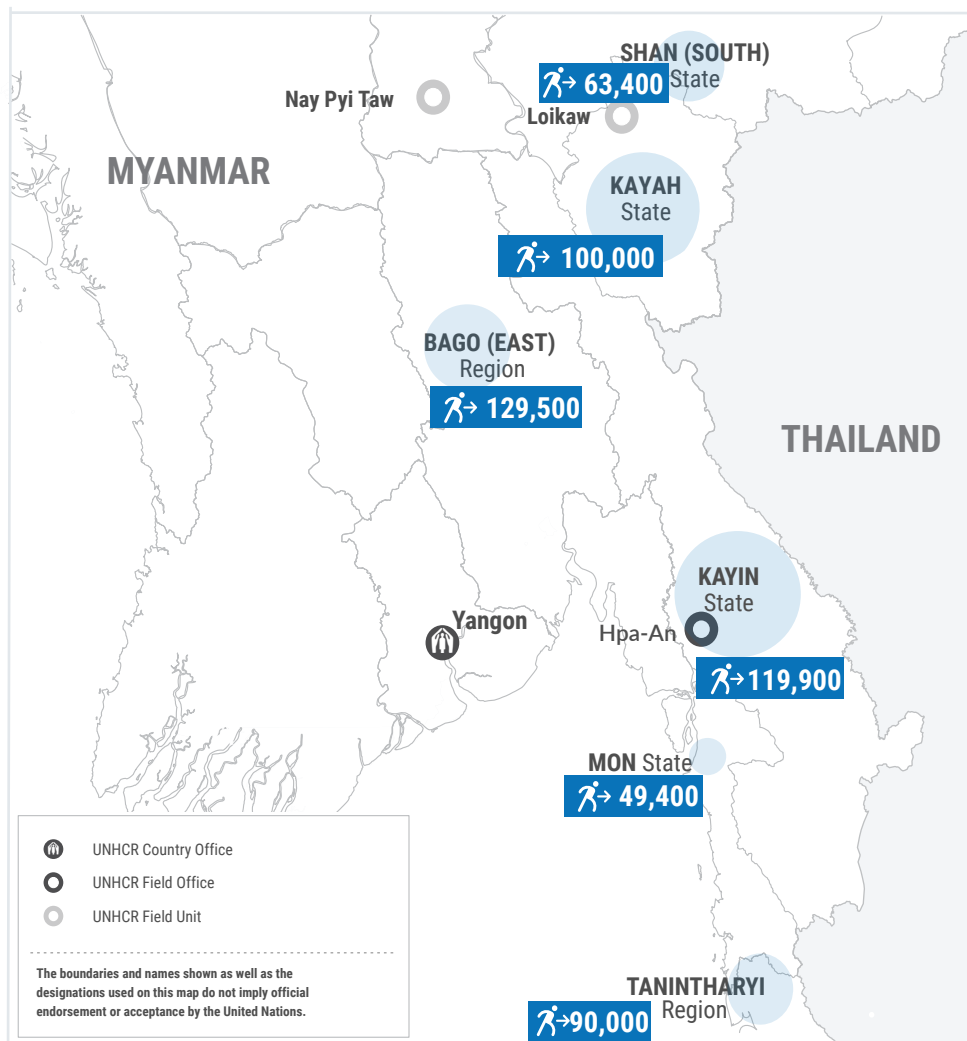
In Mon State, due to fighting, 2,316 IDPs from Kyaikto Township were displaced within the same Township. In Tanintharyi Region, due to intensified fighting, 250 IDPs in Myeik Township and 450 IDPs in Kyunsu Township were displaced within their Townships.

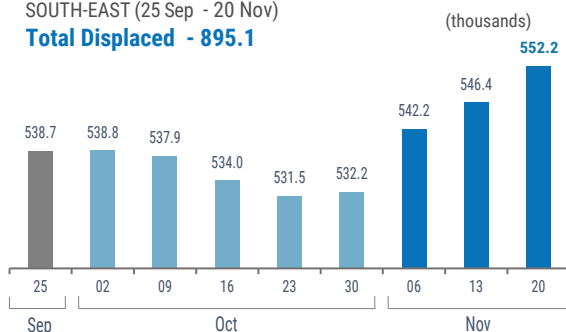
