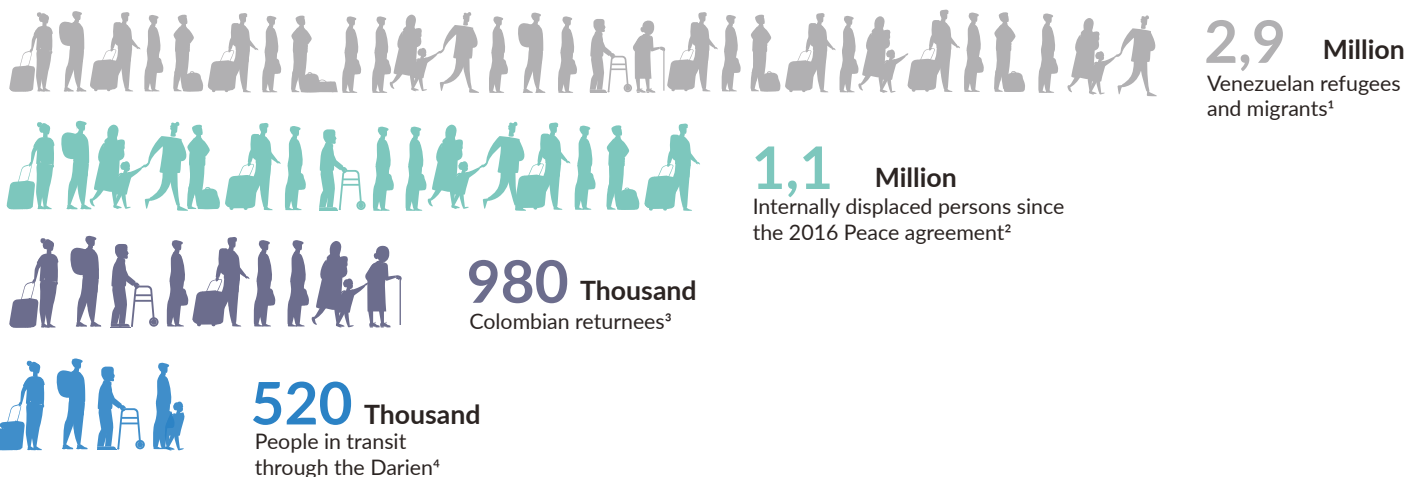

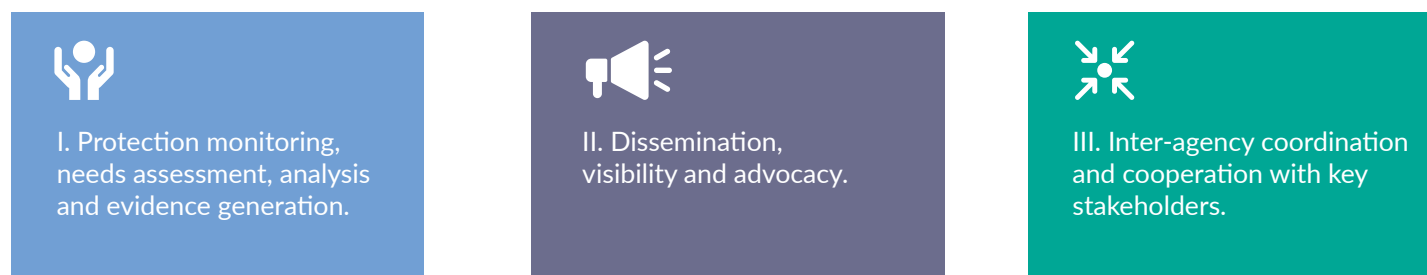

PRIORITIZED ACTIONS

Protect

- Expand the network of [Information and Orientation Centers \(PAOs\)](#).
- Provide [legal assistance](#).
- Work with new [local administrations and public institutions](#) on the needs of protection, assistance and solutions of displaced and refugee persons.
- Promote access to protection through [documentation](#) (Temporary Protection Status for Venezuelans and asylum system).
- Expand support to the [Public Ministry](#) (Attorney General's Office, National Ombudsperson's Office and Local Ombudsperson's Offices).
- Support local authorities in the [emergency](#) preparation and humanitarian response: displacement and confinement.

- Support individuals with [specific and heightened protection risks](#), including children and survivors of gender-based violence.
- Provide [shelter](#) to vulnerable people.
- Distribute [CRIs](#) and [NFI](#)s to vulnerable people engaged in mixed movements.
- Provide [psychosocial support](#).
- Ensure [access to rights and services](#): education, health.

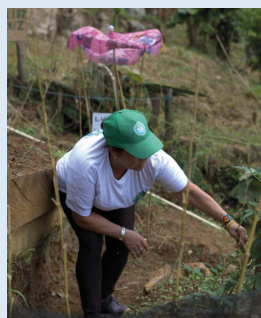
