








Movement trends by Year











Profile of persons on the move

The individuals moving cross-border within the region include vulnerable profiles with the top three being those with Serious medical conditions (21%), Single parent (18%), and Woman at risk (16%). On a socio-economic overview, there are unemployed (32%), students (18%) and skilled (17%). The top three recorded skills include Market-oriented Skilled Agricultural Workers (15%), Personal Services Workers (11%), and Agricultural, Forestry and Fishery Labourers (11%). Language proficiencies include Swahili (30%), English (18%) and Rundi, Kirundi (11%).




