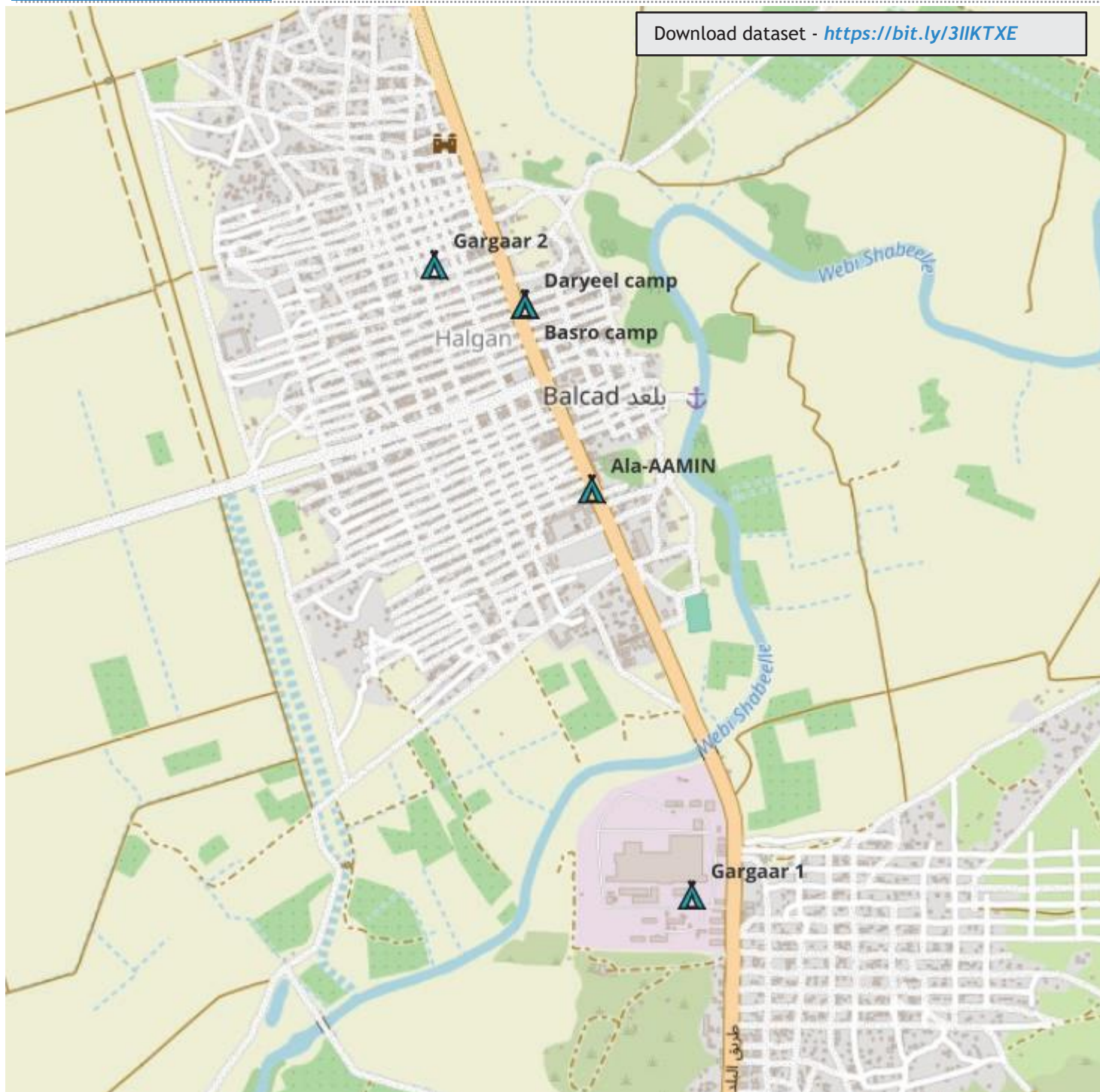

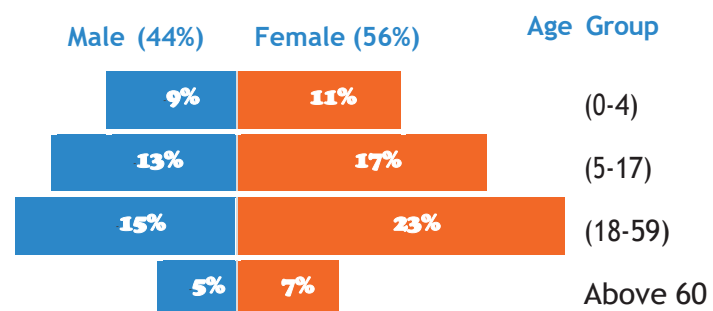


Assessment overview

In March 2024, CCCM cluster partners conducted an IDP site verification exercise in Balcad. In keeping with CCCM cluster's Standard Operating Procedures on Site Verification, local authorities, IRDO ADRO, SOVVA, and Mercy Corps participated in the exercise. 5 IDP sites hosting 5,600 households (33,600 individuals) were thoroughly verified. Compared to the last site verification conducted in April 2022, there was an increase of 2,100 Households [12,600 individuals]. The number of sites increased by 3.

Eviction Risk Mapping

All 5 IDP sites were assessed to determine risk of future eviction through using various indicators such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place, and whether eviction notices have been issued recently.

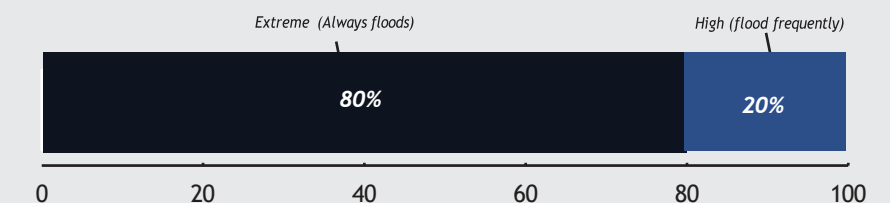
None of the IDP sites have been classified as having extreme or high risk of eviction.

- 80%** of sites have landowner authorized ownership type of land tenure
- 100%** of sites have agreement in place
- 100%** of those that have agreements have oral agreements
- 0%** of those that have agreements have no agreed end dates
- 0%** of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months

Flood Risk Mapping

All 5 IDP sites were assessed to determine risk of flooding.

100% of the sites are classified at extreme (always floods) and high (floods frequently) risk of flooding.
