- ✓ Child marriage plan: SWG's Mafrag members have recognized the need to end/minimize the phenomenon of child marriage and forced marriage.
- ✓ Awareness raising sessions and lectures.
- ✓ updating the SWG's Tasks.
- ✓ Initiate the WG work plan for 2024 and prevention activities.
- ✓ Selection of co-chair/ CP, IMC.
- ✓ Reviewing the TOR.

Mafrag Challenges:

- ✓ Low commitment to attending the monthly meeting.
- ✓ Lack of participation from the governmental parties.
- ✓ Low commitment from certain WG members for some assigned task during the different occasion.

ZRC achievements:

- ✓ updating the CPGBVWG & PWG TOR and WP with WG's members.
- ✓ sharing the best practices from GBV service providers on different GBV prevention programs.
- ✓ conducting Gap analysis exercise for GBV services in the camp.
- ✓ Conducting a joint event to celebrate the international women day.
- ✓ Setting an action plan to start working on child marriage and working on performance achievements sheet for all service providers in the camp.
- ✓ Working on revising the Sexual harassment awareness materials and shared with working group members.

ZRC challenges:

- ✓ Low participation from the governmental actors, Legal service providers and health service providers.
- ✓ Low commitment from working groups members to attend the - meeting on regular bases.
- ✓ Low commitment from the participants does or follow up the tasks provided.

- ✓ reduction of funds has notably impacted service providers and PWG members in the camp.
- ✓ Lack of Survivors' Safe Shelters in Mafraq.

ZRC 2024 Priorities:

- ✓ Support Service delivery
- ✓ Inform Strategic Decision Making

Irbid achievements:

- ✓ Developed ToR of the new IPWG , updated the 4Ws , referral pathway in order to support the service delivery.
- ✓ Created International women Day`s (IWD)Taskforces and organized joint event in Irbid and Garden Camp to mark the IWD under the theme “Making All Spaces Safe”.
- ✓ Conducted GBV safe referral trainings in Irbid, Al-Ramtha, Jarash and Ajloun for non-GBV frontline staff from various organizations and community-based organizations (CBOs) who are not specialized in GBV.
- ✓ Created World Refugee Day`s Taskforce and conducted several joint events in Irbid, Ajloun, Al-Ramtha and Garden Camp under the theme “Hope Away from Home”.
- ✓ Johud and UNHCR Marked the International Day of Older Persons, conducted joint event in Jarash princess Basma center.
- ✓ Created 16 of activism Taskforce to commemorate the 16 days of activism under the theme “Every Act Counts, Invest to Prevent Violence Against Women and Girls” .
- ✓ Created GBV gap analysis Taskforce to identify the existing gaps in programs and services related to Gender-Based Violence in Irbid, Jarash and Ajloun.

Irbid Challenges:

- ✓ Lack of the services in the remote areas.
- ✓ Participants in the Irbid coordination groups often weren't decision-makers in their organizations, turn-over, non-specialized staff participating in the meetings and sometimes lacked crucial project information.
- ✓ Some members didn't fully understand the value of coordination or lacked interest.

Irbid work plan 2024:

- ✓ Update the work plan and ToRs, 4Ws, referral pathway.
- ✓ All information related to PRT coordination including ToRs, Sops, MoMs and assessments, etc .) are shared with the members
- ✓ Review, update Amalii application information and disseminate the application.
- ✓ Develop joint activities, consult communities on strategic documents and products for the development of the campaign messages and ensure participation of protection community volunteers in coordination with the GBV SWG
- ✓ Update the GBV gap analysis.
- ✓ Identify training needs, provide support to fill gaps in terms of capacity building.
- ✓ Members of the SWG will take turn in presenting to each other their good practices at each SWG meeting.
- ✓ Enhance the coordination of the GBV prevention activities in Irbid.
- ✓ Establish child marriage Taskforce/ Network
