

#### Context

Since September 2023, over 115,257 refugees (as of May 2024) arrived in Armenia from Karabakh region. They have been recognised as Refugee under the Temporary Protection regime of the Law on Refugees and Asylum (2008) of the Republic of Armenia. Temporary protection has been granted for a duration of one year, beginning 28 October 2023, with the possibility of extension based on the Government's decision. Thus far, 91,479 have been issued with refugee documentation and 1855 have applied for naturalisation.






