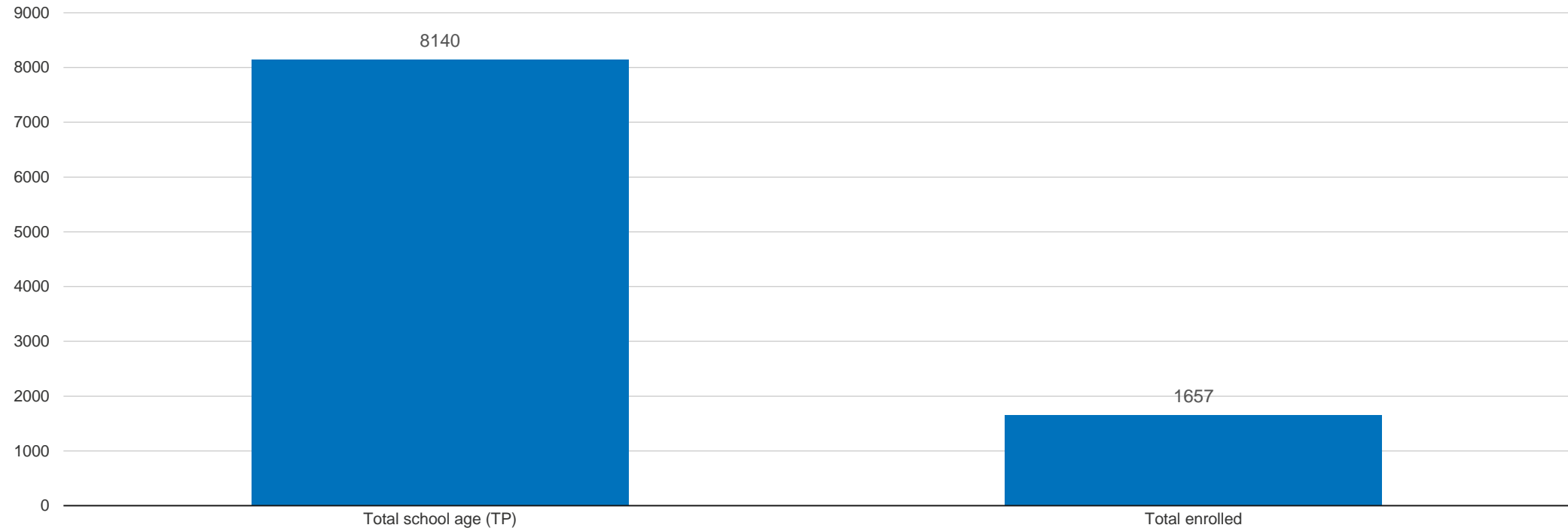

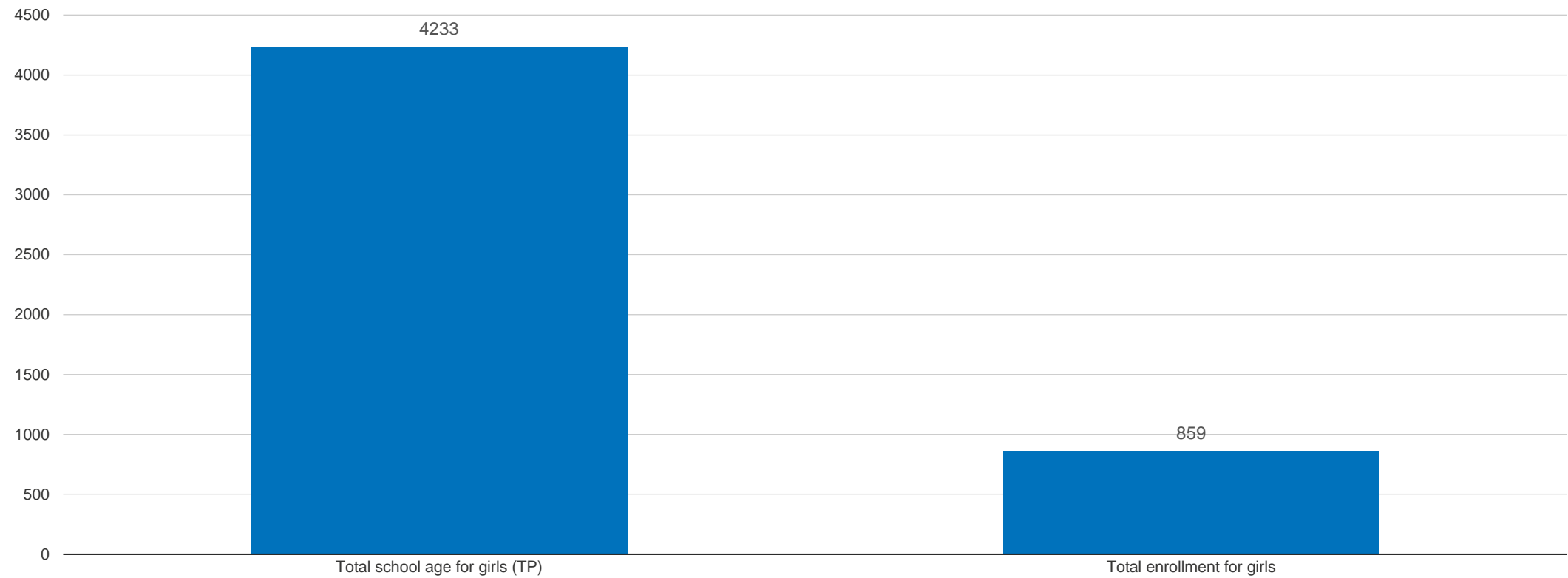
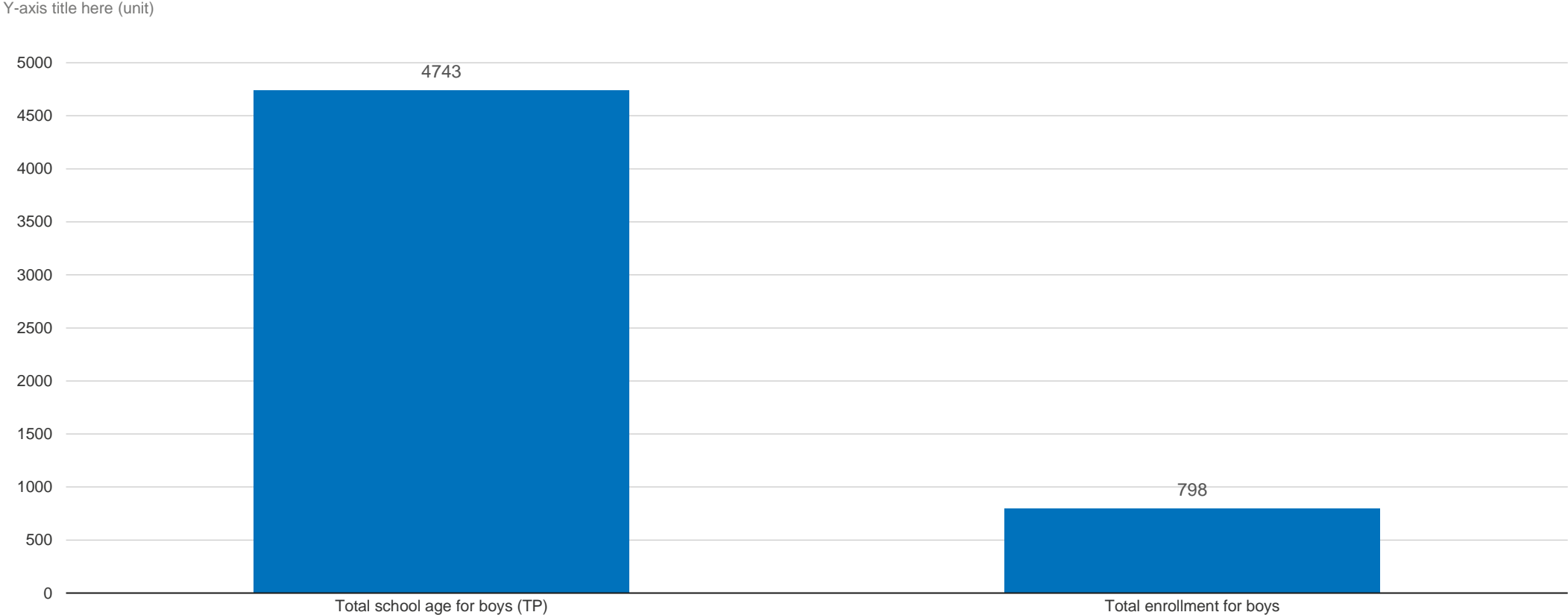

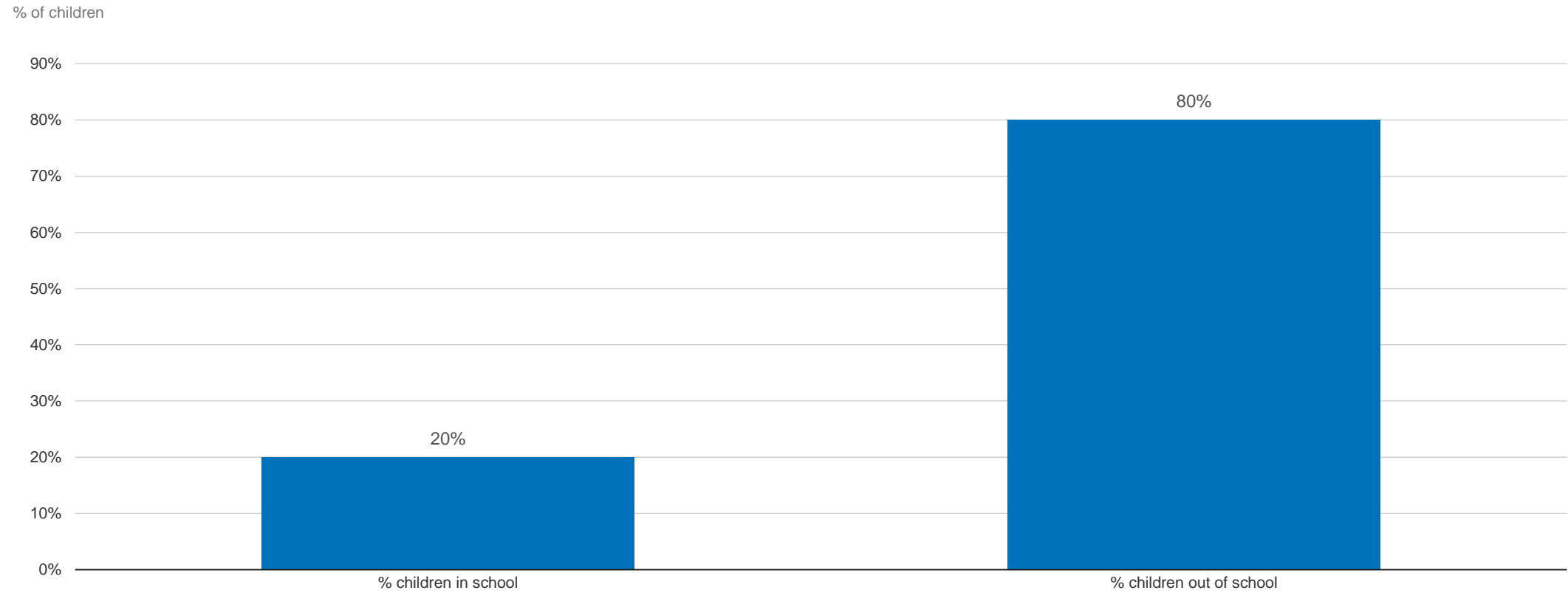
Total School Age Boys Vs Enrolled Boys-TP

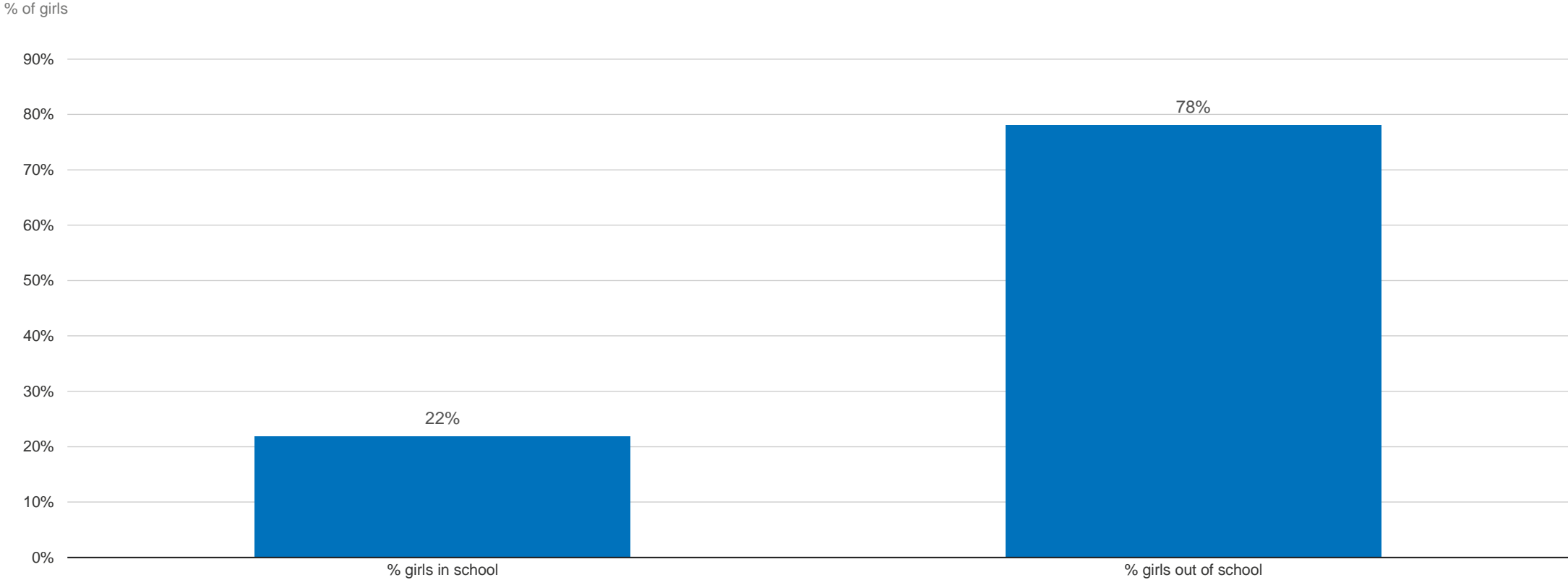
Percentage Children in School and out of School -TP

School Age Vs Enrolled Children by Region-TP

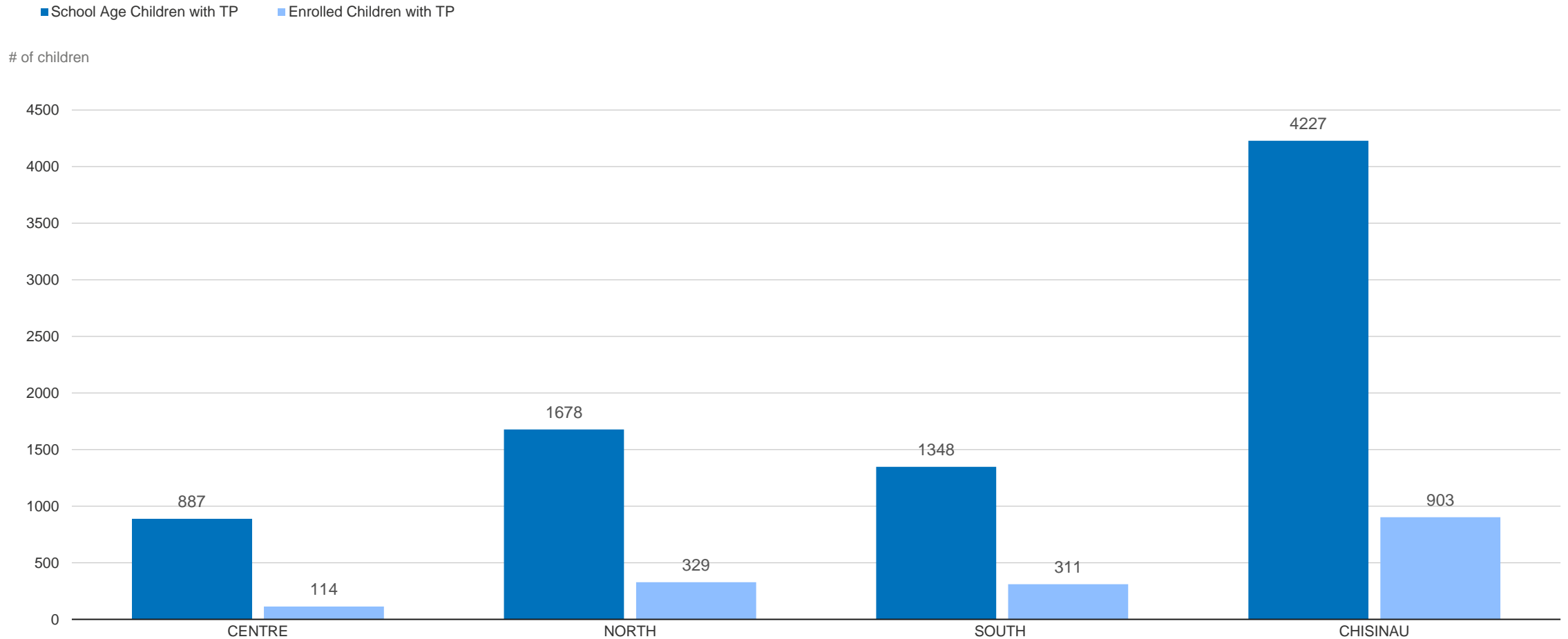

Comparison School Age Vs Enrolled Girls by Region

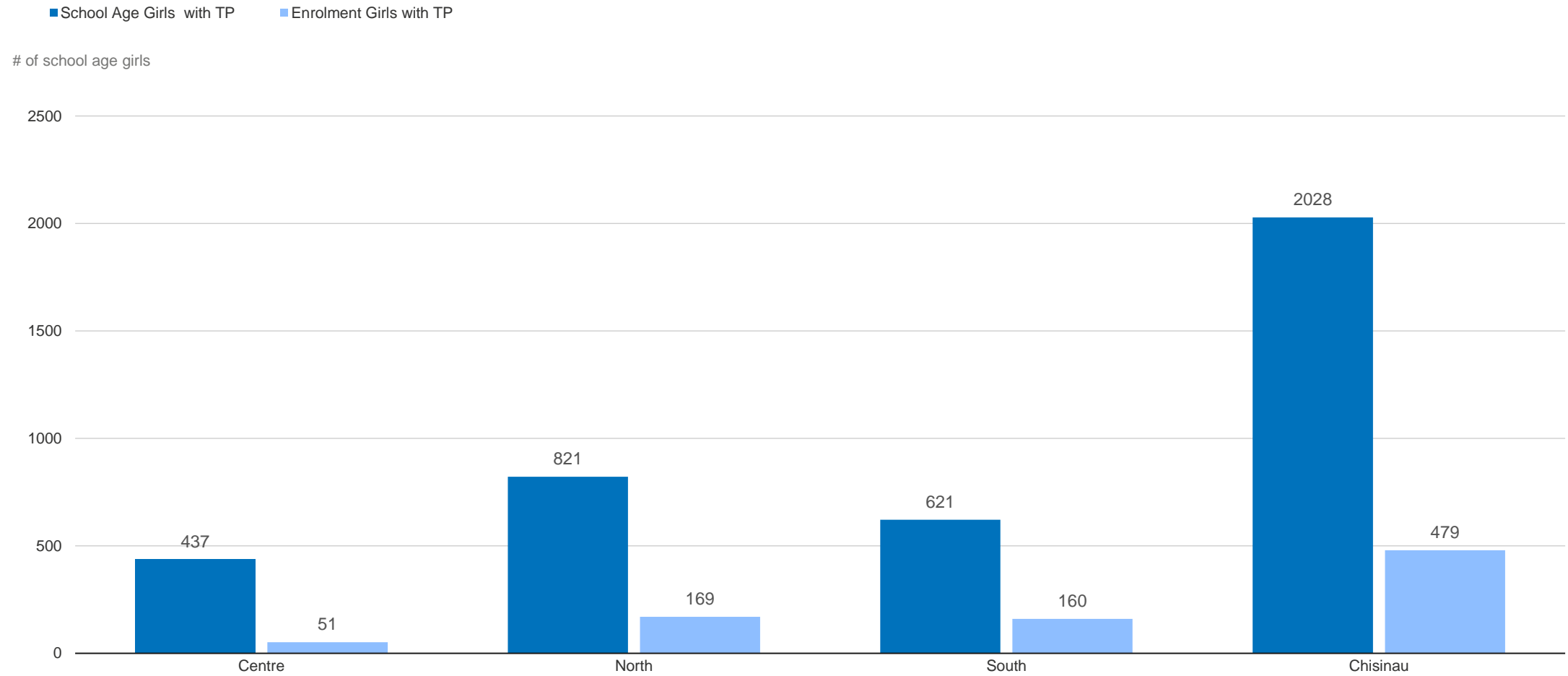
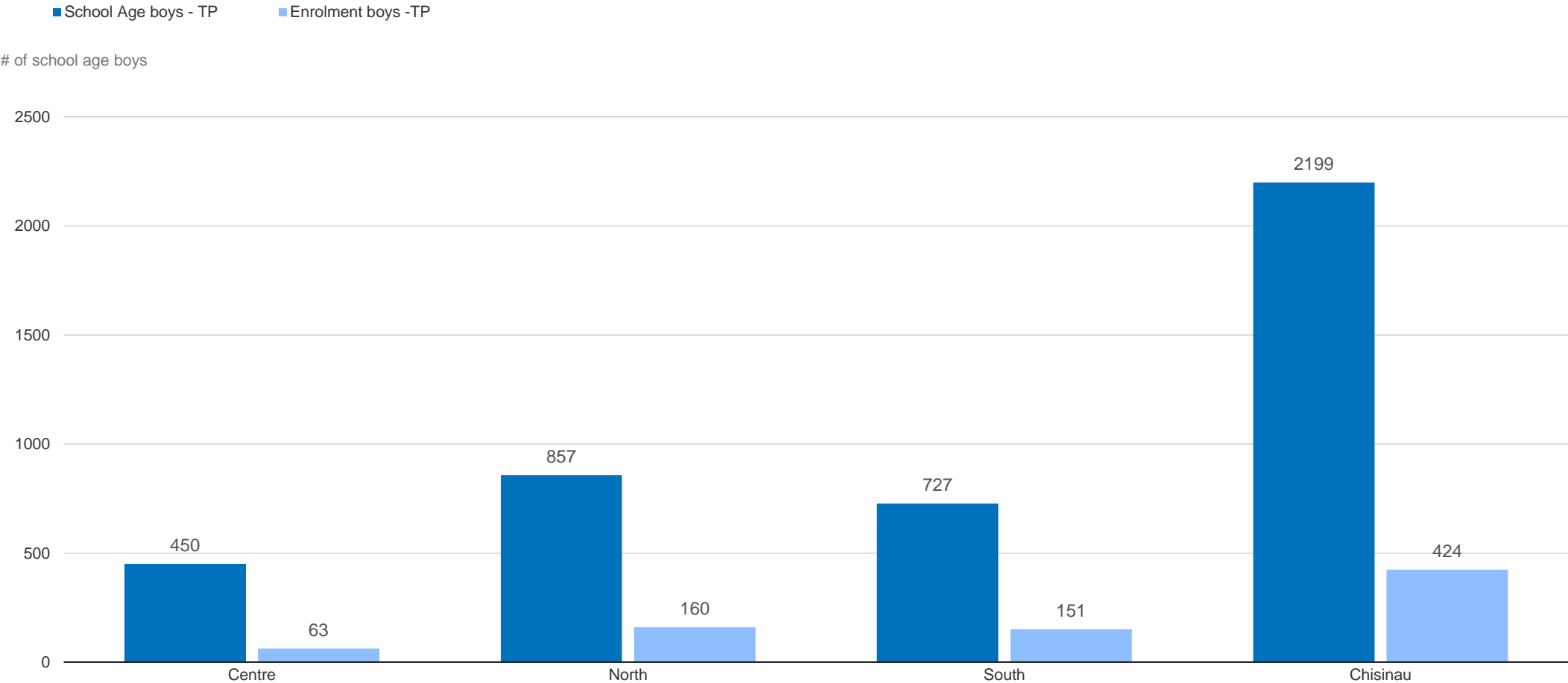

Recommendations

This analysis compares the number of children in Temporary Protection per raion, with the number of children enrolled in Moldovan schools, per raion. While enrollment of Ukrainian children is low throughout the country, this analysis highlights raions with particularly low enrollment rates. While work is needed throughout the country to support school enrollment initiatives, it is recommended that Education WG partners focus particular attention on the raions with the lowest enrollment rates. Initiatives such as small group meetings with parents to discuss their concerns related to in-person school enrollment and identify solutions, meetings between parents whose children are already enrolled and those whose children are still studying online, and work with local schools to organize “open houses” and other welcoming events for parents are encouraged.

It should be noted that this analysis was done with IGM's Temporary Protection data from 1st April, and MER education data from 7th May. Additionally, the analysis covers only Ukrainian children with Temporary Protection, and not with other forms of legal statuses. It does not provide a full picture of all refugee school age children and all children that are enrolled in schools in Moldova. Additional analyses will be conducted in the future with additional data sets, if possible.
