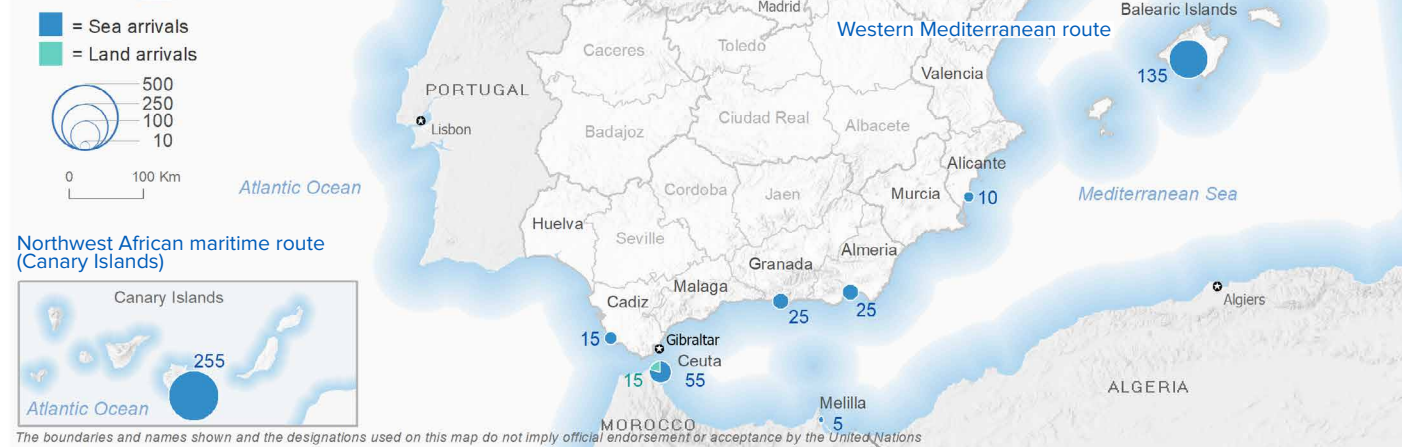


# SPAIN Weekly snapshot - Week 27 (1 - 7 Jul 2024)

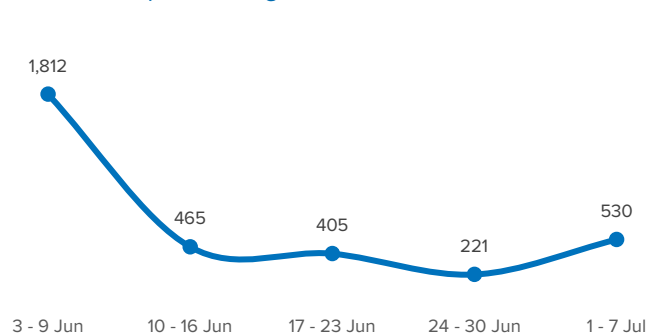

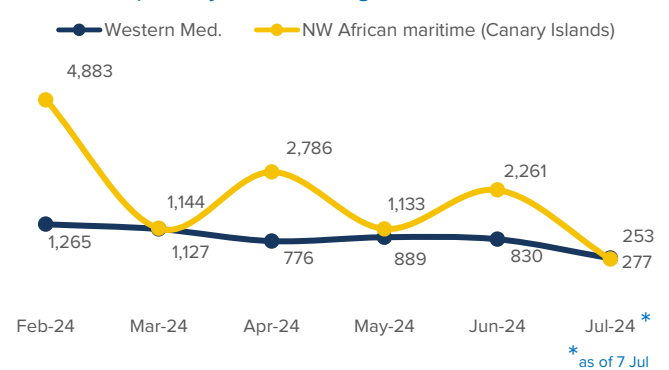

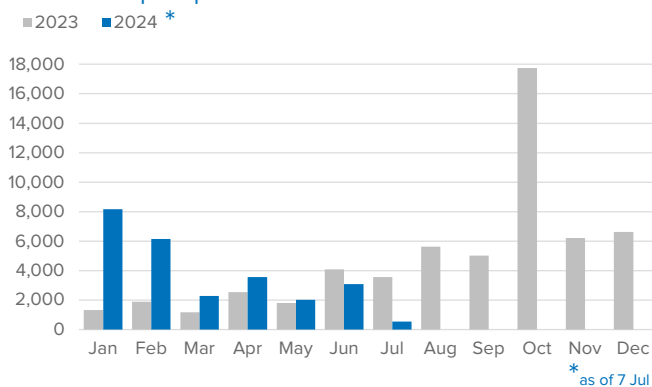
## Arrivals in Spain during the last five weeks<sup>1</sup>
