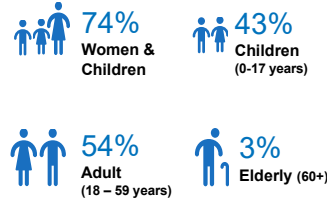

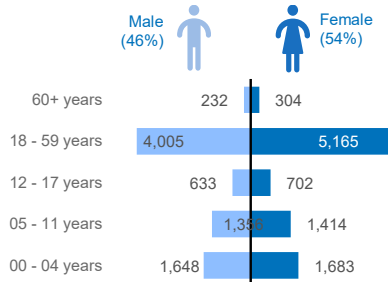

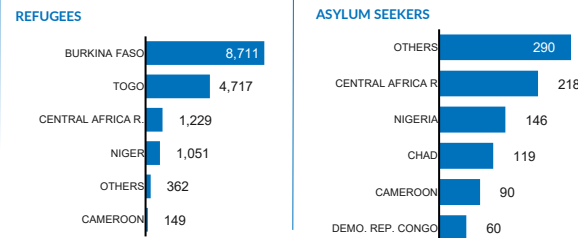

POPULATION BREAKDOWN AGE/GENDER*

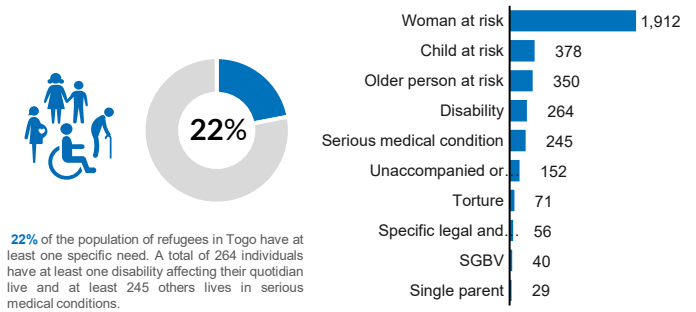

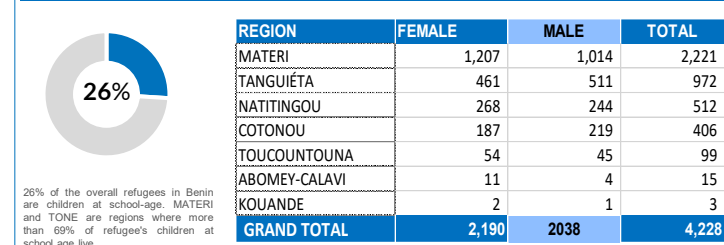
COUNTRY OF ORIGIN



PERSONS WITH SPECIFIC NEEDS

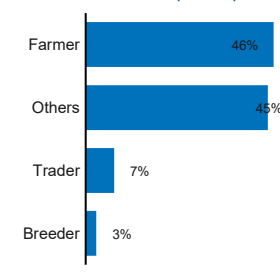


CHILDREN AT SCHOOL AGE BY REGION

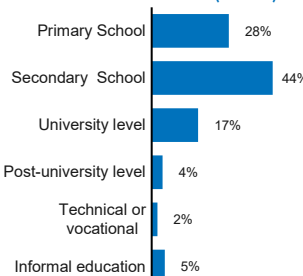

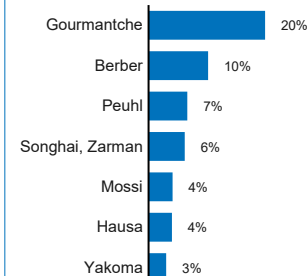
MAIN OCCUPATION (ADULT)*



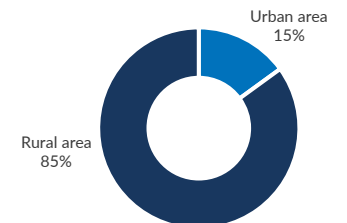
MAIN EDUCATION LEVEL (ADULT)



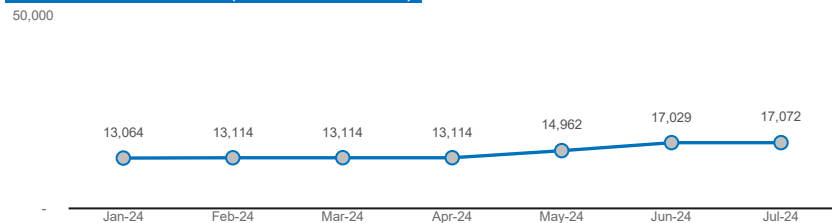
MAIN ETHNICITIES
