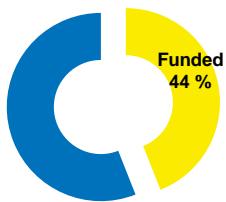

OPERATIONAL DEVELOPMENTS

Djibouti Participated in UNHCR Executive Committee Meeting.

From 14 to 18 October Djibouti took part in the 75th session of UNHCR executive committee in Geneva, Switzerland. Djibouti was represented by the Minister of Interior HE Mr Said Nouh Hassan, Djibouti's Permanent representative to the UN HE Ms Kadra Ahmed Hassan, the Executive secretary of ONARS Mr Mohamed Ali Kamil and Advisor

to the Minister of Interior Mr Yahya Mohamed Magare. Djibouti called for increased funding to enhance effective refugee inclusion in key sectors such as education and health.

UNHCR trained the members of the National Eligibility Commission on Refugee Status Determination (RSD).

On 14 October 2024, UNHCR, in collaboration with ONARS, trained 08 new members of the National Eligibility Commission on Refugee Status Determination (RSD). The workshop represents a crucial step in the collective mission to improve protection and care mechanisms for asylum seekers in Djibouti. The members of the eligibility commission have been appointed recently, replacing the ones that formed the committee before they are expected to resume work soon and clear all caseloads.

REFUGEE RESPONSE

UNHCR continued the registration of refugees and asylum seekers.

During the reporting period, UNHCR, in cooperation with ONARS, registered 10 new arrival households with 22 persons. In addition, 07 cases have been processed in the context of ongoing registration, namely 03 additions, 03 reactivations and 01 household separations, and 06 households have been pre-screened, with their inclusion in the database scheduled for next week. Regarding the renewal of certificates, 89 certificates (25 in Ali-Addeh and 64 in Djibouti) and 22 identity cards were issued in the refugee camps in Addeh and in the urban areas of Djibouti-City.

UNHCR distributed firewood to refugees in Ali-Addeh and Holl-Holl.

On 11 September, UNHCR distributed firewood to 583 refugee households in Holl-Holl, benefiting about 3,009 people. In Ali-Addeh, over 1750 households with 8724 people were served.
