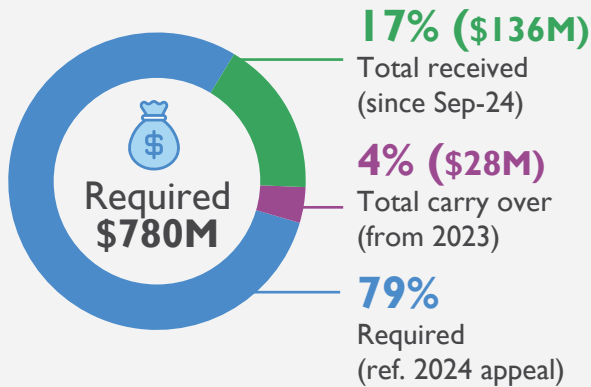


The third quarter of 2024 Food Security and Agriculture sector dashboard summarizes the progress made by Food Security and Agriculture sector partners involved in the Lebanon Response Plan (LRP) from January to September 2024. It identifies key challenges and priorities and highlights trends affecting people in need. The Food Security and Agriculture sector in Lebanon is focused on: **OUTCOME 1:** Ensuring that the most vulnerable communities in Lebanon receive food assistance to reduce their food gaps and diversify their food intake; **OUTCOME 2:** Improving agricultural production and productivity among the most vulnerable farmers through agricultural livelihoods assistance, aiming to protect, restore, and sustain their livelihoods; **OUTCOME 3:** Enhancing national capacities, coordination, and information sharing on food security and agriculture.

2024 Sector Funding Status

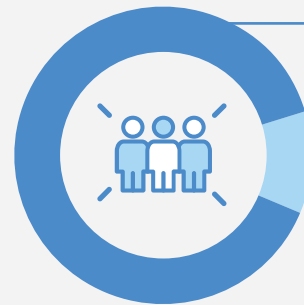
