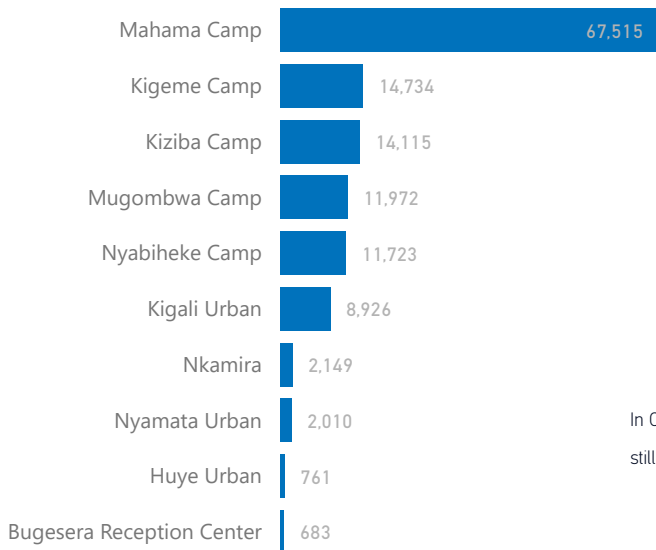

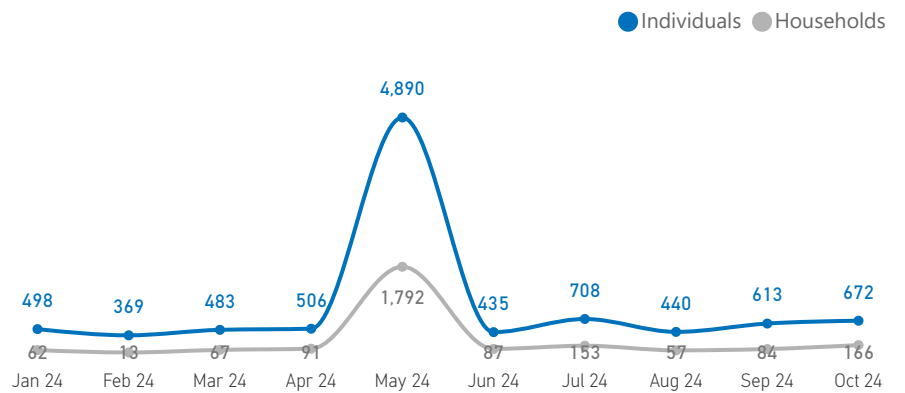

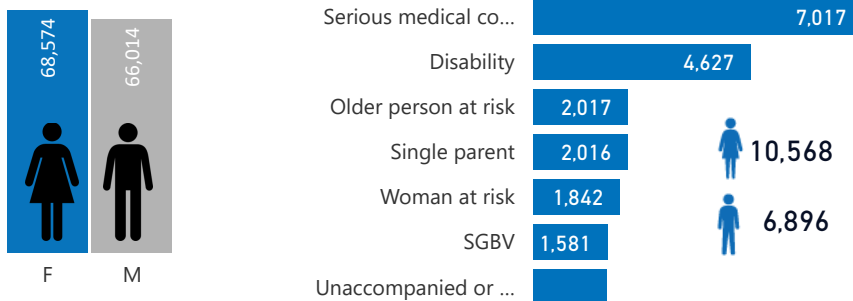


### Monthly Trend of New Registrations

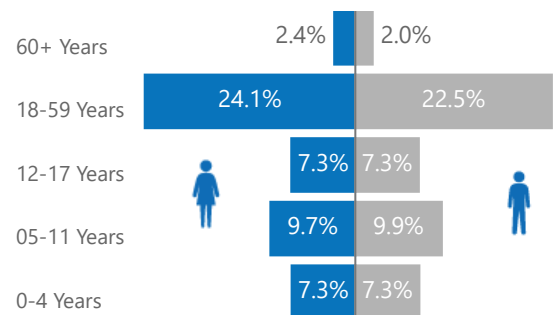


In October 2024, 148 Congolese new arrivals were received in Nkamira TC. In total, the registration of 345 new arrivals is still pending.

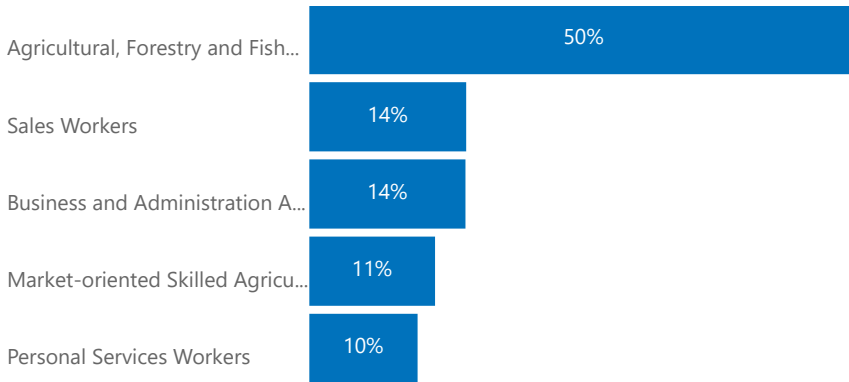

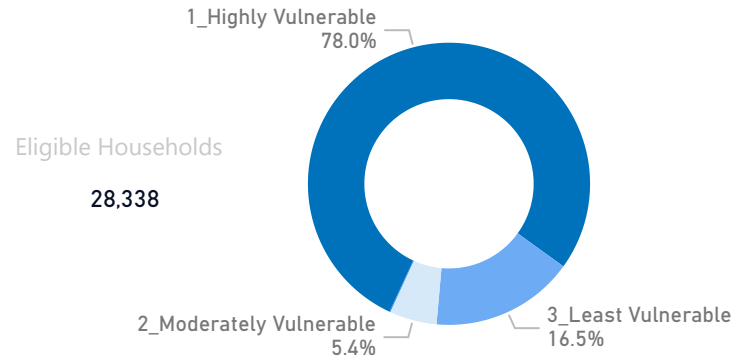


The total population of 134,588 include 114,471 refugees, 13,428 registered asylum seekers, 345 unregistered asylum seekers and 6,344 Others of concern. Since the start of 2024, more than 9,857 individuals (including 3,264 new births) have been registered in Rwanda, 77% of whom are new arrivals from DR Congo, 15% from Burundi, and 4% from Sudan. There was a decrease of 70 individuals (0.05%) in the population from last month, resulting from resettlement departures and continuous registration activities.

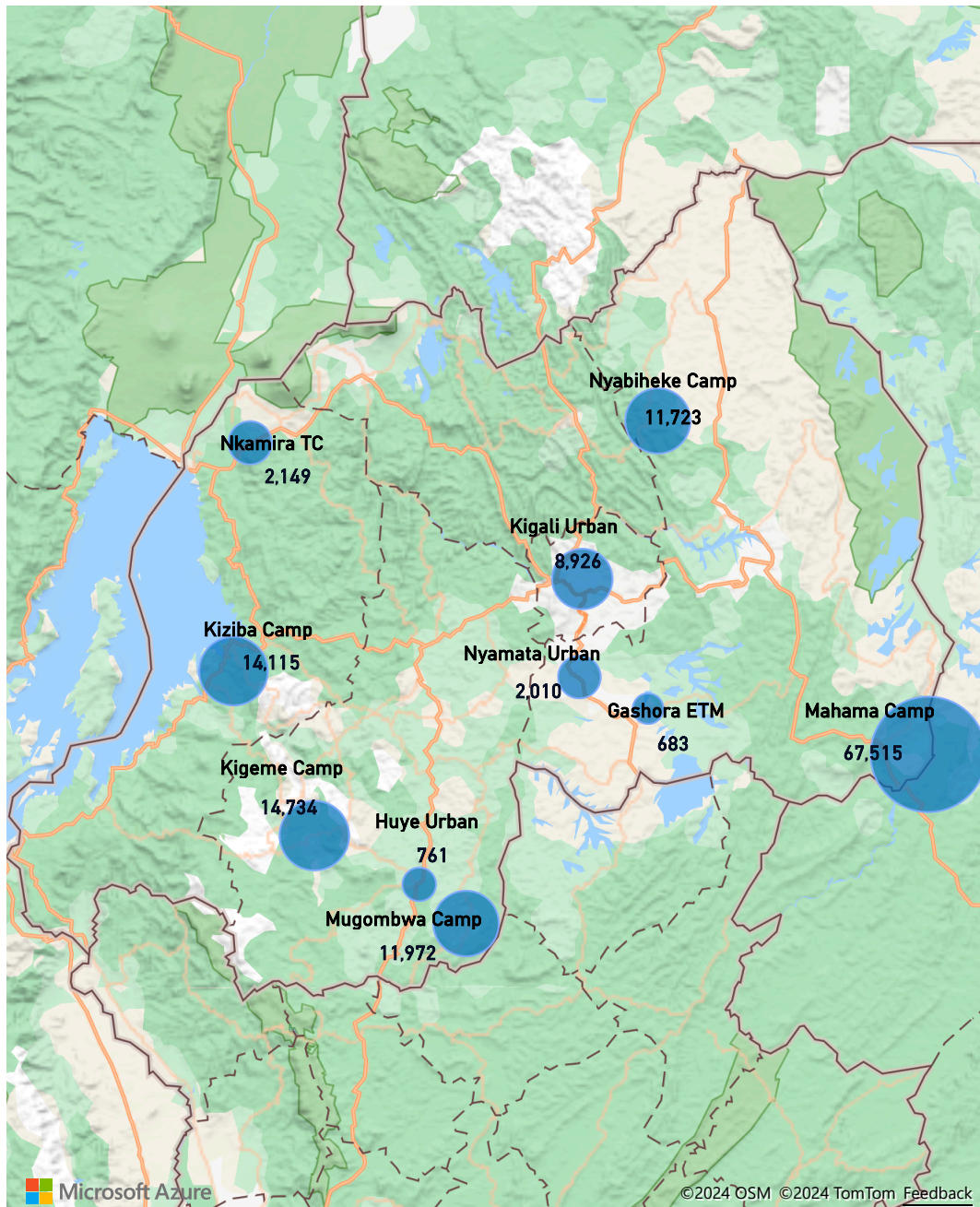

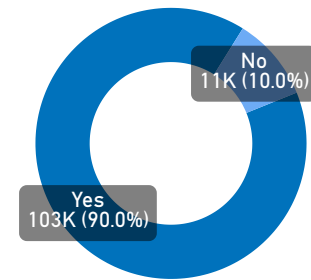
### Vulnerability Groups | Access to Food and Cash Assistance



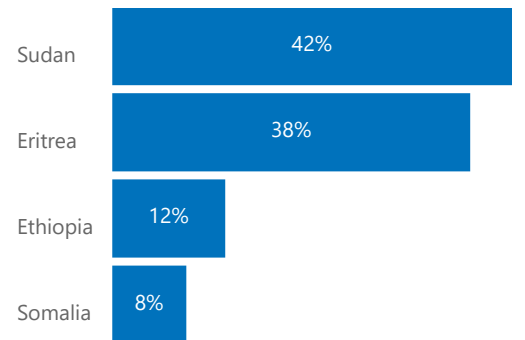
### Population Distribution by Location in RWANDA
