

# ITALY Sea arrivals dashboard

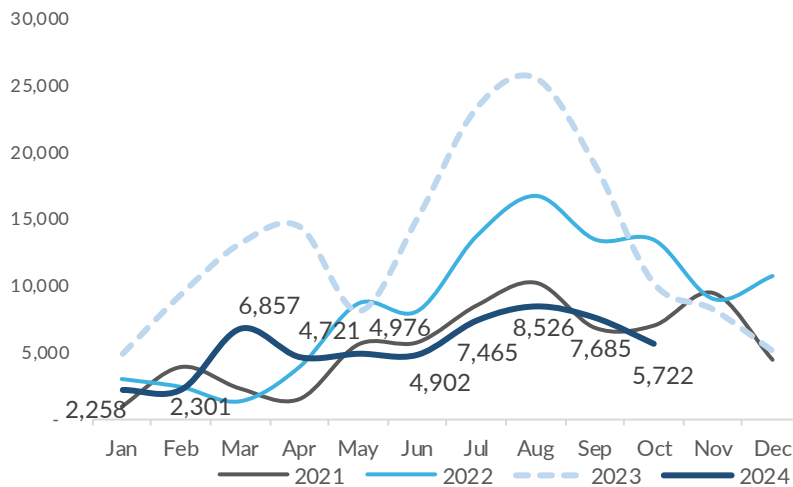
## Overview

In the first ten months of 2024, 55,413 refugees and migrants arrived in Italy by sea, compared to 144,098 in the same period last year, a decrease of 62 per cent. Almost all the 5,722 people who arrived in October disembarked in Sicily (5,065), followed by Calabria (538), Sardinia (109), Emilia-Romagna (47), Campania (41) and Apulia (22).

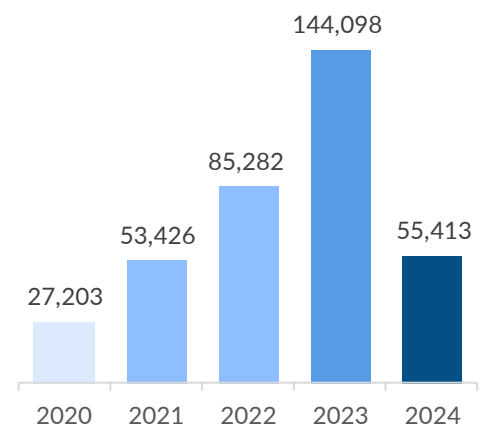
### Monthly sea arrivals

### Yearly sea arrivals

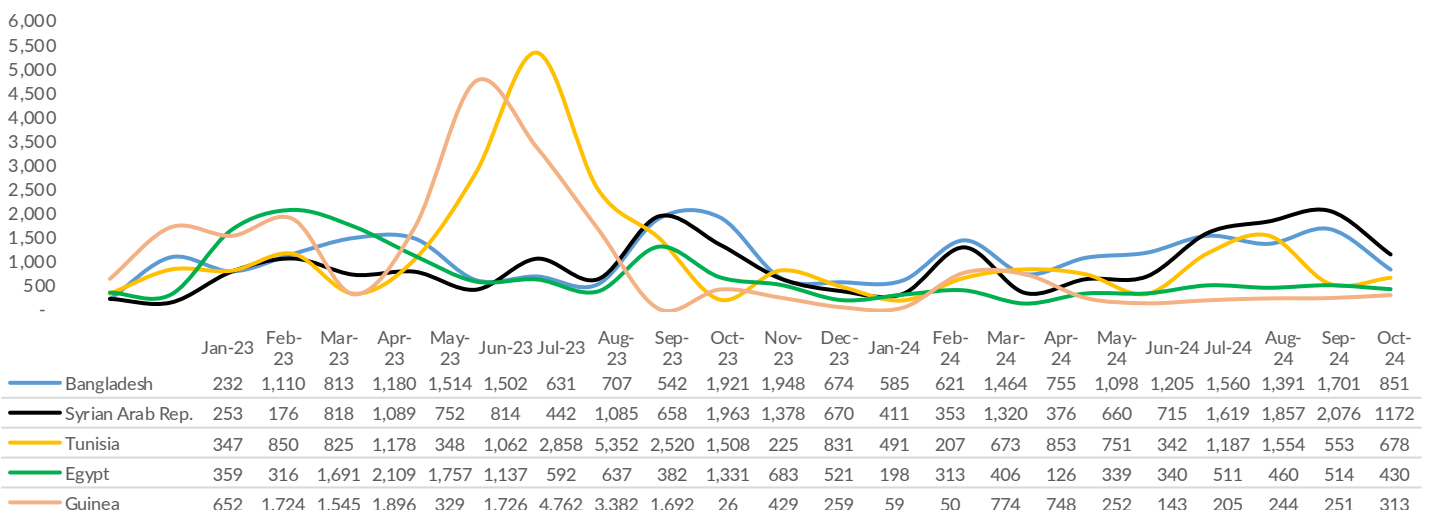
January to October, 2020-2024



## Nationality of arrivals

In October, Syrians accounted for 20 per cent of all people arriving by sea (27% in September), followed by 15 per cent Bangladeshis (22% in September) and 12 per cent Tunisians (7% in September). Among other nationalities of people arriving in significant numbers by sea were Egyptians (8%), Pakistanis and Sudanese (6% each), Guineans (5%), Ethiopians and Afghans (4% each). In October, the main nationalities of those departing from Libya were Syrian (32%, 39% in September), Bangladeshi (23%, 32% in September) and Egyptian (11%, 9% in September). Most of those departing from Tunisia were Tunisians (43%, 40% in September), Guineans (19%, 17% in September) and Sudanese (13%, 9% in September). Most of those departing from Türkiye were Afghans (54%, 30% in September), Iranians (30%, 35% in September), and Pakistanis (8%, no Pakistanis arrived from Türkiye in September). All of those departing from Algeria were Algerians (100%, 99% in September).

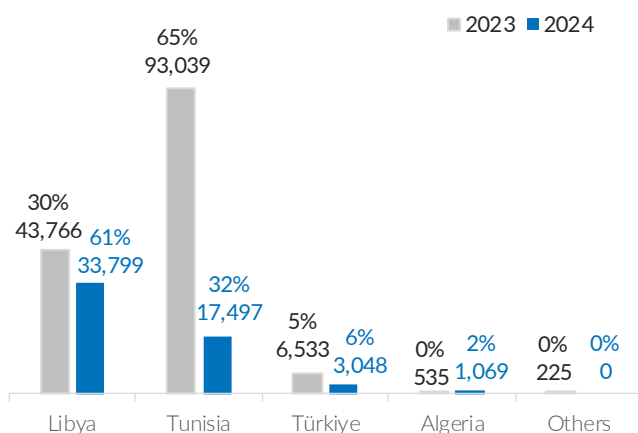
### Most common nationalities of people arriving by sea - January 2023 to October 2024



## Country of embarkation

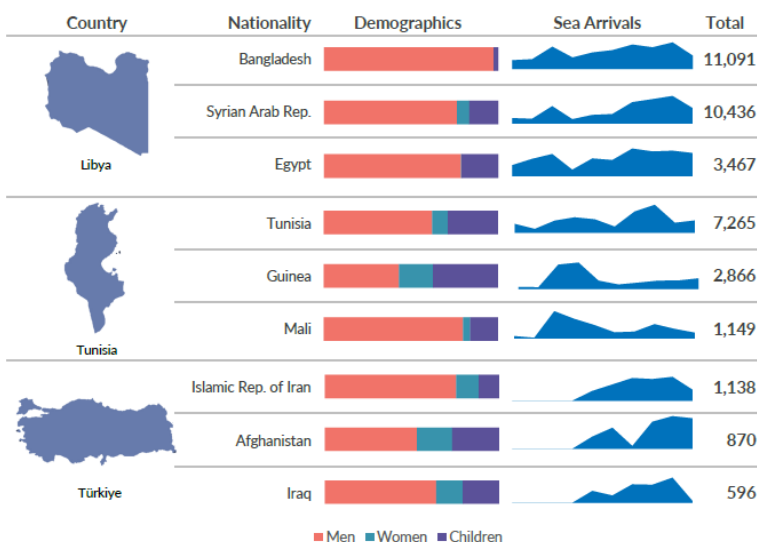
In the first ten months of 2024, 61 per cent of the people reaching Italy via sea departed from Libya (33,799 people in 719 landings), followed by 32 per cent from Tunisia (17,497 people in 596 landings), 6 per cent from Türkiye (3,048 people in 44 landings), and 2 per cent from Algeria (1,069 people in 114 landings). In October, as in September, Libya was the main country of departure (64% of all persons arriving in Italy), followed by Tunisia (28%, up from 18% in September), Türkiye (7%) and Algeria (2%).

January to October 2023 - 2024



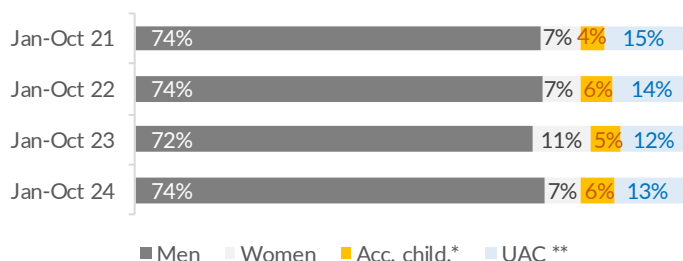

## Demographics of arrivals

In the first ten months of 2024, most people arriving by sea were adult males (74%), followed by unaccompanied children (UAC, 13%), adult females (7%) and accompanied children (6%).

In October, 390 adult females reached Italian shores, mainly originating from the Syrian Arab Republic (105), Tunisia (74), Guinea (53) and Afghanistan (44).

In the same month, 773 UAC arrived in Italy by sea. The main nationalities were Guinean (118), Tunisian (114), Gambian (89) and Egyptian (82).
