

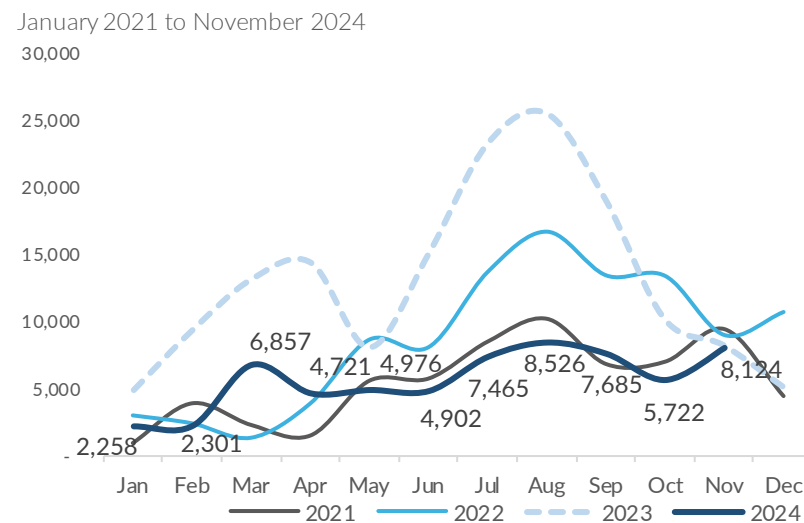
ITALY Sea arrivals dashboard

Overview

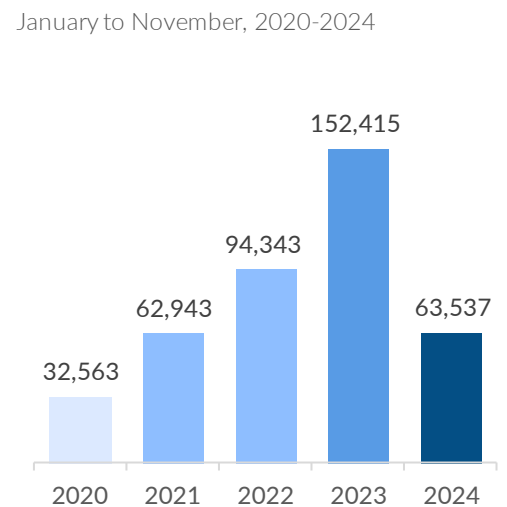
In the first eleven months of 2024, 63,537 refugees and migrants arrived in Italy by sea, compared to 152,415 in the same period last year, a decrease of 58 per cent. Almost all of the 6,835 people who arrived in November disembarked in Sicily, followed by Calabria (546), Sardinia (200), Liguria (185), Campania (114), Toscana (72), Abruzzo (50), Marche (49), Puglia (48), and Lazio (25).

Monthly sea arrivals



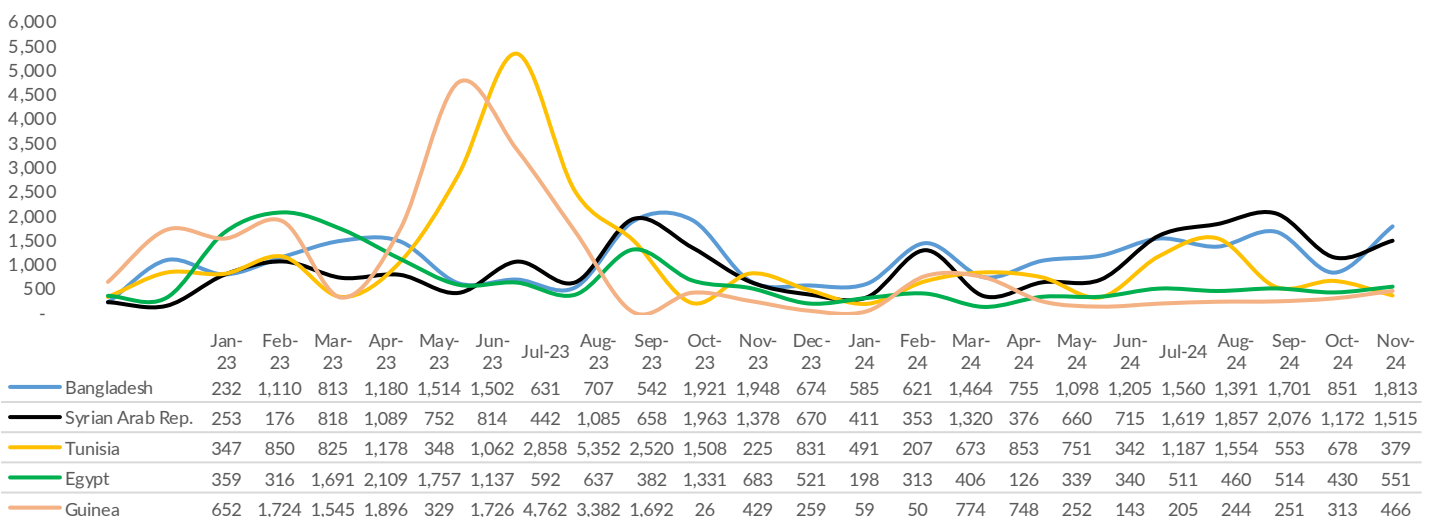
Yearly sea arrivals



Nationality of arrivals

In November, Bangladeshis accounted for 22 per cent of all people arriving by sea (compared to 15% in October), followed by 19 per cent Syrians (20% in October), and 9 per cent Pakistanis (6% in October). Among other nationalities of significant numbers arriving by sea were Egyptians (7%), Guineans (6%), Tunisians (5%), Sudanese and Eritreans (4% each), Gambians and Malians (3% each). In November, the main nationalities of those departing from Libya were Bangladeshis (30%, 23% in October), Syrians (25%, 32% in October) and Pakistanis (11%, 9% in October). Most of those departing from Tunisia were Guineans (27%, 19% in October), Tunisians (23%, 43% in October) and Malians (9%, 4% in October). Most of those departing from Türkiye were Afghans (52%, 54% in October), Iranians (19%, 30% in October), and Iraqis (14%, 3% in October). Almost all those departing from Algeria were Algerians (98%, 100% in October).

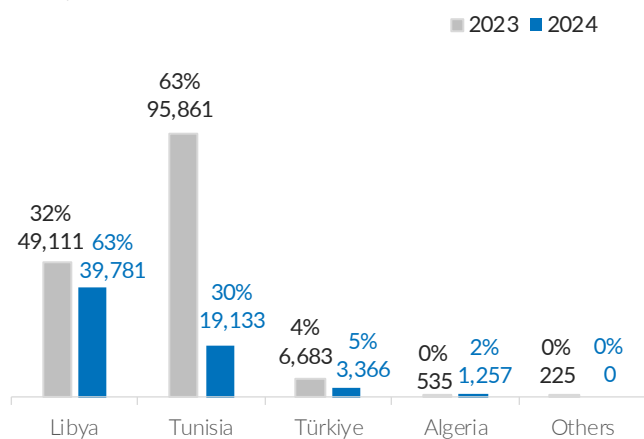
Most common nationalities of people arriving by sea - January 2023 to November 2024



Country of embarkation

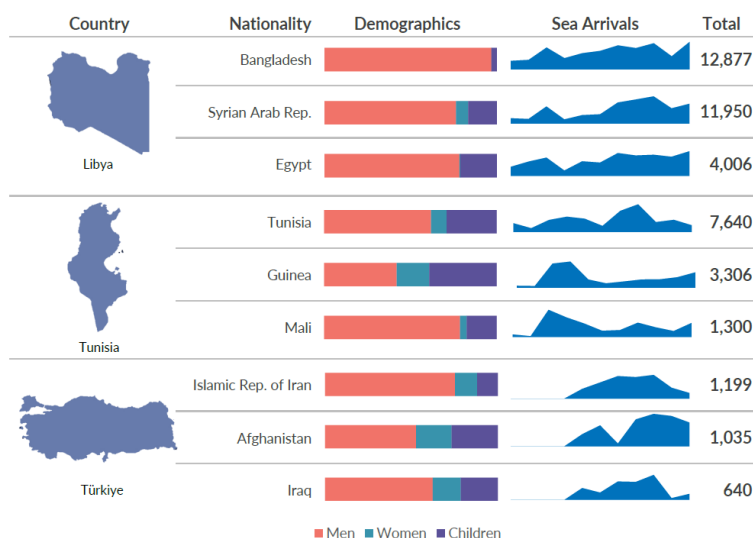
In the first eleven months of 2024, 63 per cent of the people reaching Italy via sea departed from Libya (39,781 people in 854 landings), followed by 30 per cent from Tunisia (19,133 people in 645 landings), 5 per cent from Türkiye (3,366 people in 48 landings), and 2 per cent from Algeria (1,257 people in 131 landings). In November, as in October, Libya was the main country of departure (74% of all persons arriving in Italy) by sea, followed by Tunisia (20%, down from 28% in October), Türkiye (4%) and Algeria (2%).

January to November 2023 - 2024



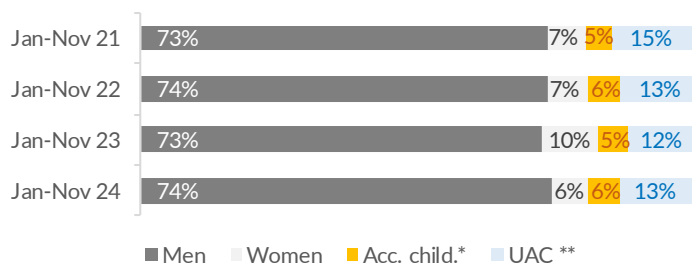

In the first eleven months of 2024, most people arriving by sea were adult males (74%), followed by unaccompanied children (UAC, 13%), adult females (6%) and accompanied children (6%).

In November, 485 adult females reached Italian shores, mainly originating from the Syrian Arab Republic (129), Guinea (66), Cameroon (38) and Afghanistan (36).

In the same month, 1,215 UAC arrived in Italy by sea. The main nationalities were Guinean (208), Gambian (156), Eritrean (126) and Egyptian (116).
