

## WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

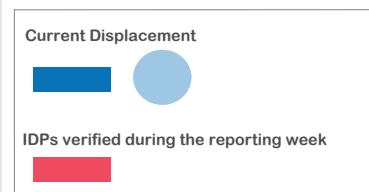
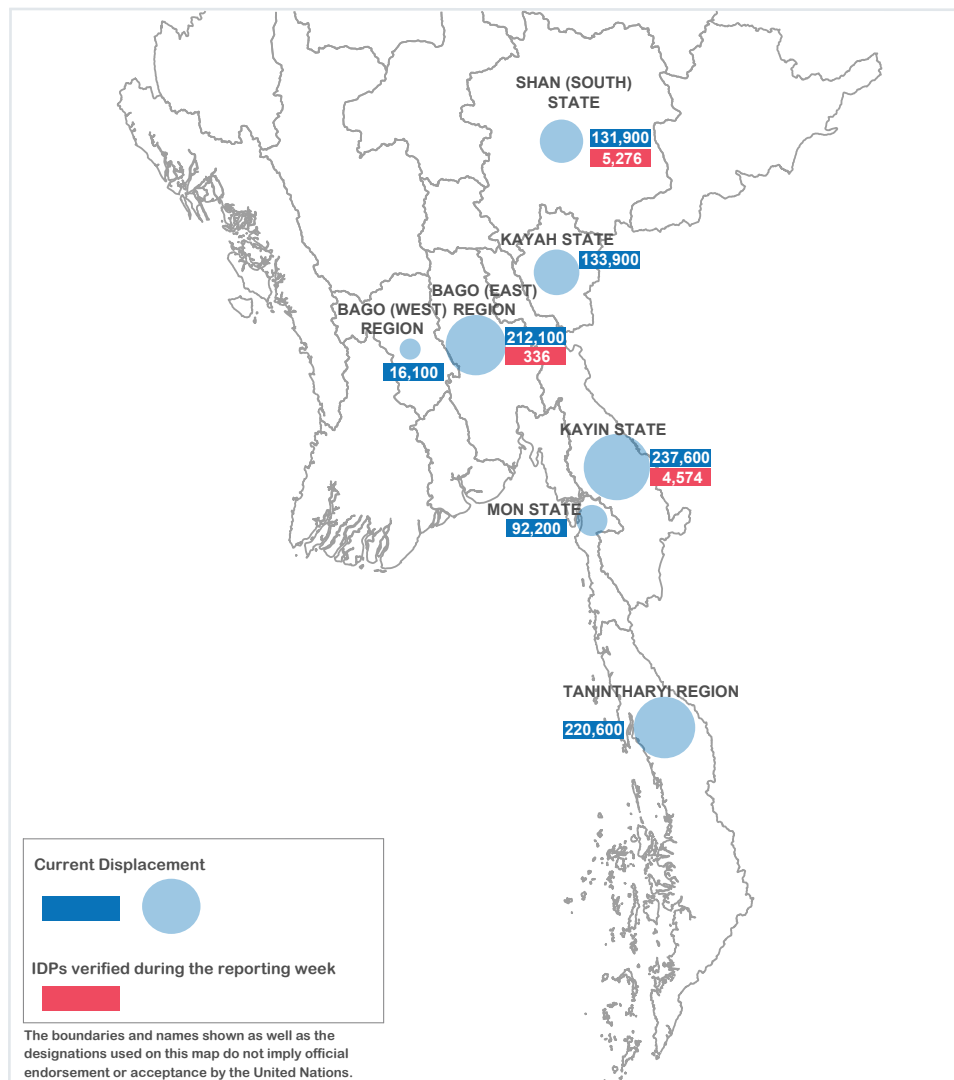
In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) increased from 1,035,200 last week to 1,044,400 this week.

In Kayah State, 4,555 people from Yan Koke and Dauk Pa Lan villages, in Kawkareik Township were displaced within the same township due to intensified fighting.

In Shan State (South), armed clashes, airstrikes and shelling forced 800 people to flee within Pekon Township were and displaced 950 IDPs for a second time. Other 2,404 people from Nan Toke village, in Pinlaung Township were displaced to Pinlaung town and Naungtayar Town due to the fighting in the area. Pekon Township also received 1,122 people Loikaw Township (Kayah State) due to armed clashes, airstrikes and shelling in their places of origin.

In Bago Region (East), 336 people from Hle Lan Ku village, Htantabin Township were newly displaced to Taungoo Town due troop reinforcement carried out by the Tatmadaw.

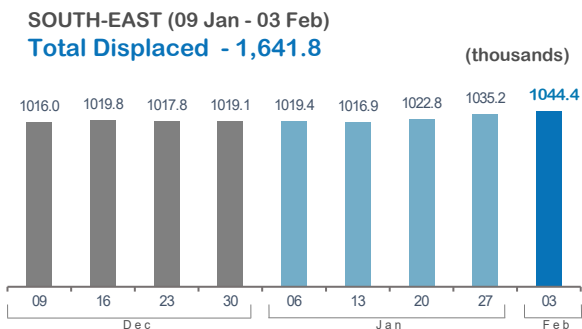
