


WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of IDPs decreased from 1,040,900 last week to 1,036,600 this week.

In Kayin State, the conflict is escalating in the Kyondoe area, Kawka-reik Township, resulting in the displacement of an estimated 523 people—249 fled to Hpa-An Township and 274 to Hlaingbwe Township due to continued airstrikes and indiscriminate shelling during the reporting period.

In Mon State, 4,775 IDPs reportedly returned to their places of origin in Bilin Township. Intensified clashes in the Me Pa Li area following the Ethnic Armed Organizations' capture of a Tatmadaw base on 4 February 2025 had caused their displacement. They returned to their villages of origin following relative stabilization in the area.

Total Displaced - 1,722.2


