

In Syria, an estimated 7.4 million individuals remain internally displaced (IDPs), residing both within communities and in IDP sites. As of 19 June 2025, 5.1 million are estimated to be living outside IDP sites, while 1.35 million reside in 1,671 IDP sites and camps in Northwest Syria (NWS) and Northeast Syria (NES).

The events of November 27, 2024, and recent incidents have triggered further displacement, with over 679,499 new IDPs reported as of June 19, 2025.

At the same time, IDP returns continue, with 1,472,626 individuals reported to have returned home since November 27, 2024, including **590,107** returning from IDP sites since December 8, 2024
